DUBAI WORLD CUP POSTPONED After

further torrential rain and a severe lightning storm at Nad Al Sheba racecourse, the organizers of the \$4 million Dubai World Cup were forced to abandon Saturday's international event. The track and surrounding areas were under several inches of water. Michael Osborne, Chairman of the Dubai World Cup Organizing Committee, said: "There was no chance of staging the race. We had two inches of rain in 2 1/2 hours. We also had a severe lightning storm and we couldn't risk putting horses and jockeys in a steel starting gate. We couldn't race later in the day because the water was not draining away and anyway it would have been unfair to subject top-class horses to such conditions. The forecast is now for good weather for four days and we need three days for the track to dry out, so the plan is to stage the race on Thursday (April 3). Sheikh Mohammed has spoken to all the trainers and they are all keen to stay and run for however long it takes. The only exception is Helissio (Fr) (Fairy King), who will go home if there is one drop of rain."

AMERICAN-BRED TAKES GROUP ONE DOWN

UNDER American-bred six-year-old Secret Savings (Seeking The Gold) gave his trainer Gai Waterhouse an unprecedented fourth win in a row in the \$791,515 G1 Doncaster H. over a mile at Randwick in Sydney Saturday. Bred by Ogden Mills Phipps and owned by His Excellency Nasser Lootah of Dubai, the 8-1 Secret Savings overtook stablemate All Our Mob (Aus) (What A Guest {Ire}, by Be My Guest), off at 9-2, inside the final furlong to win by a long neck, with 10-1 shot Ravarda (Aus) (Rave Report {Aus}) three-quarters of a length away third. "His Excellency told me if I could get him to win a Group race in Australia, he would send me many more to train," said Waterhouse. "Well, Secret Savings won a Group 3 first time up and has now won a Group 1. He's the easiest horse in the stable to train. To win four straight Doncasters, well, it's a dream."

Concerto has been beaten only once since breaking his maiden last September at Belmont Park, finishing second by three-quarters of a length to subsequent GI Florida Derby winner Captain Bodgit in last year's GIII Laurel Futurity. Looking for his fourth straight since, the chestnut was 6-5 to stretch the streak and did so before a record Jim Beam crowd of 20,237, racing just off the leaders to the far turn before moving to challenge and assuming the lead just before INEXCESSIVELYGOOD (In Excess {Ire}) broke down near the sixteenth pole. "I'm coming up a little short on words," said winning trainer John Tammaro III. "You work so hard with the horses... this one is very special to me. As far as I'm concerned, he's the best." The colt, the first to follow a successful prep in the John Battaglia Memorial with a victory in the Jim Beam, sported a shadow roll for the first time in the Beam; he will be pointed for the GI Kentucky Derby May 3. Inexcessivelygood suffered a dislocated compound fracture of his right front ankle and had to be put down. His jockey, Chris McCarron, was taken to St. Luke's Hospital West; he suffered three broken ribs. Trainer Nick Zito, who saddled the second and third-place finishers, said Jack Flash would now head for the GII Toyota Blue Grass at Keeneland April 12, and Shammy Davis will also run at Keeneland next, but in another spot. JULES (Forty Niner) set a torrid pace, running the half in :44 3/5 and three-quarters in 1:08 4/5 before tiring to fourth. "He just ran too fast," said trainer Alan Goldberg. "He didn't rate. He is going to have to learn how if we are going to consider the Derby." The colt will likely head to the Blue Grass as well.
