### KEENELAND SPRING MEET OPENS TODAY

Keeneland Race Course opens its 16-day spring meeting today. The opening-day feature is the \$65,000 Appalachian S. for three-year-old fillies. Saturday's feature is the \$500,000 GI Ashland S. The race is headed by **Glitter Woman** (Glitterman), a winner of all three of her starts this year by a total of 26 lengths. The probable field of six also includes 1996 champion 2-year-old filly **Storm Song** (Summer Squall). A plethora of Kentucky Derby hopefuls will take to the Keeneland track for the \$700,000 GII Toyota Blue Grass April 12, including **Pulpit** (A.P. Indy), **Acceptable** (Capote) and **Wrightwood** (Seattle Slew). Keeneland will run at least one stakes race daily during its spring meeting. Mondays and Tuesdays will be dark and post time for the first race each day will be 1:10 p.m.

### SYDNEY YEARLING SALE GROSSES \$34

**MILLION** Records were broken at the 3-day Inglis Easter yearling sales in Sydney, Australia, when 436 youngsters were sold for a gross of \$34,155,454--an average of \$78,339. Last year's average was \$54,144. The sales topper was the Danehill colt out of the Group One-winning Last Tycoon (Ire) mare Lady Jakeo (Ire). Once again the Danzig stallion dominated proceedings with his 41 yearlings sold grossing \$8,413,804, 24.6 percent of the sale and an average of \$205,215. Sadler's Wells had the highest average price at the sale. His two colts and two fillies averaged \$300,776. Inglis's managing director Reg Inglis said: "This sale was strong from the beginning to the end. There is a lot of optimism in the breeding industry and that will flow through to the 720 broodmares which we will sell here next week." The top price on the final day of the sale was paid for a Danehill filly out of Australian Oaks winner Savana City (Aus) (New Regent). The filly was bought by the powerful German-backed Victorian company Roselands for \$379,927.

Siphon (Brz) did not break sharply but quickly moved up to set the pace with **FORMAL GOLD** (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) and **KEY OF LUCK** (Chief's Crown) in hot pursuit. Bet down to 6-5, the Santa Anita H. winner opened up his lead at the top of the stretch as Formal Gold and Key Of Luck weakened, but he was soon joined by Eclipse winner Singspiel (Ire), who rallied up the rail, battled briefly with the pacesetter, then responded to the urgings of new jockey Jerry Bailey to win in his first start since taking the G1 Japan Cup last November, and his first start on the dirt. "The pace horse was holding firm and I just managed to hit the front," said Bailey. "It's a great credit to Singspiel and a credit to (trainer Michael Stoute) that he got by Siphon." Siphon held on well to be second, while stablemate Sandpit (Brz) ran an even third. "I am pleased with the way they ran," said Richard Mandella, who sent out the two Brazilian-breds. "I was hoping Singspiel wouldn't be so good on the dirt, but he's great on both." The third American entrant, Formal Gold faded to fifth. "He broke well and he was up there early on, which is where I didn't want to be," said his trainer, William Perry. "He was just a little fresh. I am a little disappointed but we still picked up a check." **FLEMENSFIRTH** (Alleged), given a great chance after working well over the Nad Al Sheba sand track, rated in midfield early but had no closing kick. "I was happy with his position at half-way; from the five-furlong mark I made a move, but he flattened out and struggled up the straight. He finished tired."

Sixth in the Breeders' Cup Classic to end his 1996 campaign, Tamayaz returned from a four-month layoff to be second to TROPICOOOL (Carr de Naskra) in the Maktoum al Maktoum Challenge over this track February 27. ## WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES

### PEDIGREE SHORTS...

Although he was a stakes winner at two, three and four, it wasn't until his five-year-old career that Black Tie Affair reached his peak. For that reason, it was always in the cards that his stud record would improve as his runners matured. This seems to be the case, as following the Grade I triumph by Formal Gold, Black Tie Affair was represented by his second graded stakes winner of the season when **Washington Color (c, 3, Black Tie Affair {Ire}--Jump with Joy, by Linkage)** took the G3 Yukan Fuji Sho Crystal Cup at Nakayama in Japan Sunday. The three-year-old was a \$300,000 purchase at last year's Fasig-Tipton Calder Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale. His pedigree is interesting in that his dam is inbred 4x3 to Turn-to, while Black Tie Affair carries Ambiorix II, a half-brother to the dam of Turn-To. In addition, Washington Color's second dam is by Restless Native, who is by Native Dancer out of a Bull Lea mare while Black Tie Affair is a great-grandson of Raise a Native who is by Native Dancer out of a mare by Bull Lea's genetic relative Case Ace.

A somewhat similar inbreeding is apparent in the pedigree of **River Bay (c, 4, Irish River {Fr}--Buckeye Gal, by Good Counsel)** who took the G2 Prix d'Harcourt at Longchamp on Monday. The broodmare sire Good Counsel is a grandson of Turn-to. Irish River's maternal grandsire Klairon is a close genetic relative to Ambiorix II and is from the same female line as Turn-to. In tail-male line Irish River goes back to Nasrullah while in tail-female line, River Bay goes back to Nasrullah's sister Malindi. All in all, a very clever pedigree.

**Smokin Mel (c, 3, Phone Order--She's Smokin, by Husar {Mex})**, who defeated several highly-touted colts to claim the GII Gotham S. Saturday, has a pedigree to ponder. The distaff side of the pedigree boasts an almost complete absence of well-known names. In fact, She's Smokin's sire is Mexican-bred and the second dam is by Prince Khal-Ran out of a mare by Barouche--not exactly names which appear in graded stakes-winners week in and week out. The most familiar strain in the pedigree is that of Good Doctor, the sire of Smokin Mel's broodmare sire, Husar. Good Doctor is by Dr. Fager out of Speedwell (a three-parts sister to Secretariat) and is a brother to the dam of Cure the Blues.
