**SIPHON TO AIRDRIE STUD** According to the *Thoroughbred Times* on-line edition, MGISW **Siphon (Brz)** (Itajara {Brz}) will head to Airdrie Stud in Midway, Kentucky to stand stud at the end of his racing career. The six-year-old South American import has won 12 of his 22 career starts, including the GI Hollywood Gold Cup last year and the GI Santa Anita H. in March; he finished second in the Dubai World Cup Thursday to bring his career earnings to \$2,573,619.

**GRAND NATIONAL DRAWS 38** Thirty-eight runners will line up for today's \$400,000 Martell Grand National Steeplechase over four-and-a-half miles at Aintree in Liverpool, England. Highweight in the field is 22-1 **Master Oats (GB)** (Oats {Ire}) at 164 pounds; the 11-year-old captured the 1995 Cheltenham Gold Cup. He is followed by 14-1 **Nahthen Lad (Ire)** (Good Thyne) at 149; 11-1 **Lo Stregone (Ire)** (The Parson {GB}), 144; and 1997 Grand National Trial winner **Suny Bay (Ire)** (Roselier {Fr}) and the 1996 Irish Grand National hero, 25-1 **Feathered Gale (Ire)** (Strong Gale {Ire}), both at 143. There are four jumpers leading the morning-line odds at 9-1; they are **Avro Anson (GB)** (Ardross {Ire}), 142; **Lord Gyllene (NZ)** (Ring The Bell {NZ}), 140; **Wylde Hide (Ire)** (Strong Gale {Ire}), 140; and **Suny Bay (Ire)**; **Go Ballistic (GB)** (Celtic Cone {GB}), 140, is next in the early betting at 10-1. Only one American-bred runner will test the course at Aintree this year, that being **Evangelica** (Dahar), 140; the seven-year-old Kentucky-bred mare is being offered at better than 50-1.

Top filly **Sharp Cat** (Storm Cat) may not have the dosage to get it done against colts on the first Saturday in May, but the first Saturday in April could be a different story. Unchallenged against fillies in her last four, the chestnut will try to match the accomplishment of 1988 Santa Anita Derby winner **Winning Colors**. But she faces a stiff test against the likes of **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck), a lightly raced colt who has never finished worse than second; the Bob Baffert charge makes his second start around two turns after finishing second to **Free House** (Smokester) in the GI San Felipe S. last out.

**Glitter Woman** (Glitterman), whose connections put up \$6,000 to make her eligible for this year's Triple Crown, obviously relished the going at Gulfstream this winter as she powered her way through three smashing graded stakes victories. Never worse than second in her eight career starts, the Shug McGaughey trainee has also run well at Aqueduct, Arlington, Belmont and Churchill, and should handle this surface and her Ashland rivals as well. Eclipse Award winner **Storm Song** (Summer Squall) broke her maiden at Keeneland last April and ended her 1996 campaign with back-to-back wins in the GI Frizette and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies but has not returned to top form at three, finishing fifth behind **Glitter Woman** in two starts this year.

The one-time world-record holder will go over the million-dollar mark in career earnings with a win here. **Tejano Run** (Tejano) raised eyebrows with his 123 Beyer speed figure taking the GIII Widener H. at Hialeah last out. The five-year-old has started three times since spending nearly 10 months on the sidelines, winning twice; he becomes a millionaire if he finishes in the top five. The accomplished mare **Halo America** (Waquoit) has already bankrolled more than \$1 million and has never been worse than second over this track. She takes on the boys after besting the girls by four lengths in the GIII Oaklawn Breeders' Cup H. March 23.

Yesterday's opening-day attendance at Keeneland, which featured the first live race calls in the track's history, was 12,001, up nearly 32 percent from last year's opening crowd of 9,093.

The 16th running of the GII \$600,000 Jim Beam S. at Turfway attracted a Beam record crowd of 20,237, and set records for total betting and out-of-state simulcasting as well. The total handle for the March 29 card was \$12,922,029, up 3.5 percent from the 1996 Jim Beam program; the out-of-state total, boosted by a record 561 outlets as compared to 375 in '96, was \$7,780,933, up 5.7 percent.

Jockey Willie Martinez, who took five races on the Jim Beam card, clinched the leading rider title at the Turfway winter/spring meet which concluded Thursday with 83 victories. Finishing a distant second was Francisco Torres with 42 winners. It was Martinez' sixth Turfway title. D. Wayne Lukas saddled 27 winners to top the trainer standings for the eighth time at the track, while W.T. Young's Overbrook Farm captured the owner's title with 14 victories.
