SKIP AWAY TO LONE STAR Last year's Eclipse award winning three-year-old Skip Away (Skip Trial) will likely make his next start in the Texas Mile at Lone Star Park after officials at the Texas track announced the purse for the April 20 race had been increased from \$100,000 to \$250,000. Skip Away would become the first Eclipse champion to race in Texas. Explaining the purse increase. Lone Star Park Vice President and General Manager Corey Johnson said, "Our goal has always been to bring world class horse racing to North Texas. This purse increase just reinforces the strength of our racing program. We have received a tremendous amount of interest in the Texas Mile from the connections of the top horses around the country. With the opportunity to attract Skip Away and other top horses, we decided that this is the step that we needed to make." In his two previous 1997 starts, Skip Away finished second in both the Gi Donn H. and Gl Gulfstream Park H.



The proposal calls for 14 new riverboat casinos. Currently, Illinois has 10 riverboat casinos, six racetracks and a network of off-track betting parlors owned and operated by the tracks. Lang is projecting an increase of \$1.4 billion per year in revenue for state and local governments if his plan is adopted. In an attempt to appease Republican Governor Jim Edgar, who is dead-set against gambling expansion, Lang is proposing using the gambling funds to underwrite a \$10 billion bond issue for school construction.

SHIRLEY HEIGHTS: AN APPRECIATION by Bill Oppenheim

"I grow old ... I grow old ... I shall wear the bottoms of my trousers rolled."

--T.S. Eliot, "The Love Song of J. Alfred Prufrock"

I made my third trip to Newmarket for Tattersalls' Houghton yearling sale in the autumn of 1981, and I have one outstanding recollection from that trip--Shirley Heights' first yearlings. I had always been a big fan of Mr. Paul Mellon and his great champion Mill Reef, so I was naturally at least a bit interested in the first year ings by his first top son, winner of the 1978 English-Irish Derby double; but I was in no way prepared to be so bowled over by the immense quality of the Shirley Heights yearlings. I just thought they oozed class. This I thought was amazing considering he hailed from what would at the time have politely been called a 'rough' female line, but I think this was very much the Mill Reef showing through.

That brought Shirley Heights to my attention, and by the time Slip Anchor led pillar-to-post in the 1985 Epsom Derby, following the victory of another son, Darshaan, in the previous year's French Derby, Shirley Heights was firmly established among the front rank of European sires. When he died earlier this week at the age of 22, Tony Morris noted in the Racing Post that Shirley Heights had sired a total of 30 Group or Graded SW (among 51 SW in all) in England, Ireland, France, and the U.S. in his first 13 crops, though he has no GSW yet among his 1996 3- or 2-year-olds.

Shirley Heights has always been a Classic sire, and in recent years many of his top horses have stayed at least 12f., sometimes even 2m+, such as the 1994 Ascot Gold Cup (2 1/2m) winner Arcadian Heights. They've always had a well-deserved reputation for temperament, too: his fillies are notorious tail-swishers, and while in many cases that signals ungenuine runners, in Shirley Heights' case it seemed to be more temperament than non-triers. One of his good colts, Head for Heights, a dual 12f G2 winner from his second crop, was so sav age he was reportedly eventually put down at stud.

For all that, Shirley Heights has continued to be an important Classic influence, both as a sire of sires and as a broodmare sire. His best son at stud has undoubtedly been Darshaan, who's been threatening to throw a real star for a few years now and certainly did in

Europe's top 3-year-old miler of 1996, Mark of Esteem, now ensconced at Sheikh Mohammed's Dalham Hall Stud, where he will get a major shot. Shirley Heights has been a good broodmare sire, too; his best producing daughter has been High Hawk, winner of the G2 Ribblesdale from his first crop and dam of three GSW by Sadler's Wells, including In the Wings, sire of 1995 Irish Derby winner Winged Love and 1996 globetrotter Singspiel in his first crop.

I've become increasingly cagey over the years about predicting long-term influences and trends as the numbers of the thoroughbred breed have exploded over the past twenty years--who would have thought then that the very survival of the Bold Ruler sire line might depend on just how good A.P. Indy and Capote turn out to be? Shirley Heights may or may not turn out to be a name seen much in pedigrees in years to come; but as a sire of racehorses, especially middle-distance runners and stayers, and at least as a first-generation influence, he's definitely been a Name in the 'Eighties and 'Nineties. I for one hope his influence will long survive in pedigrees: he sired class.
