### SYDNEY BROODMARE SALE UP 67 PERCENT

As had been widely forecast, this week's broodmare sale conducted by William Inglis & Son in Sydney, Australia, followed the trend set at last week's Easter yearling sales and recorded a huge 67 percent hike in average. The 583 broodmares sold at the four-day sale grossed \$15,988,602, for an average of \$31,444, compared to last year's \$18,802. Reg Inglis, Managing Director of the sales company, said: "This is by far and away the best ever broodmare sale we've ever had. Following their successes in the yearling sale ring last week, breeders have shown their long-term confidence in the Australian bloodstock market by investing strongly at the broodmare sale." The sale topper was Northwood Park's mare **Northwood Plume** (Military Plume {NZ}, by Sir Tristram), who won the VRC Oaks, the G1 VATC Thousand Guineas and the G1 STC Ansett Australia S. In foal to the champion sire Danehill (Danzig), Northwood Plume, brought a final bid of \$554,060 from the British Bloodstock Agency (Ireland). The mare will stay in Australia at Jim Fleming's Tyreel Stud. Another high-priced mare was the 1992 G1 Caulfield Cup winner **Mannerism** (Amyntor {Fr}, by Sir Gaylord), who was bought by Geoff and Beryl White for \$474,909. She too is in foal to Danehill and will be bred to the White's foundation stallion Marscay later this year. Fifteen mares were sold for more than \$158,303. Nine are in foal to Danehill, two to Last Tycoon (Ire), two to Breeders Cup Mile winner Baratheia (Ire), one to American 'shuttle' stallion Brocco and one to Nureyev.

The five-year-old mare has been off since that effort. **Jewel Princess**, last year's champion older filly, has won both her starts this year, the GI Santa Maria H. in February and the GI Santa Margarita March 9. The seven-year-old **Halo America** (Waquoit) will be making the final start of her career in the Apple Blossom. The grey mare comes into the race off a four-length win in the Mar. 23 GIII Oaklawn Breeders' Cup H.

## Local News, France:

French trainer Jean Lesbordes suffered a family tragedy Wednesday when his 23-year-old son Clement died in a road accident at Chantilly in France. The young amateur rider fell off his bicycle and was hit by a passing truck. Lesbordes, who trained Nononito to win last year's G1 Prix du Cadran and finish 3rd in the Ascot Gold Cup, made international headlines in 1993 when his filly Urban Sea won the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in Paris.

Last season's G1 Cheveley Park S. winner **Pas De Reponse** (Danzig) faces three fillies in today's Prix Impudence over seven furlongs at Maisons-Laffitte. The filly, trained by Criquelette Head, is aiming towards the Newmarket 1000 Guineas May 4.

## Local News, England:

**Sleepytime (Ire)** (Royal Academy), favorite for the May 4 Newmarket 1000 Guineas, has been given the go-ahead to run in next Friday's G3 Fred Darling S. at Newbury after veterinary tests revealed that she is free of the infection currently affecting trainer Henry Cecil's string. Cecil said: "Sleepytime has been given the all-clear and is still on target to run at Newbury. One or two of my horses have a respiratory infection, but she seems fine." Immediate plans for Cecil's other distaff Classic hopes are still to be decided. But **Reams Of Verse** (Nureyev), winner of last September's G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot, looks set to go straight to the 1000 Guineas without a prep.

European champion juvenile **Revoque (Ire)** (Fairy King) was supplemented to the Epsom Derby for a fee of \$12,780, according to a report in yesterday's *Sporting Life*. Trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam told the *Sporting Life*, "It's very early to say whether he will run or not. I think he will stay a mile and a quarter, but we will know more when he has run in the Guineas."

**Personal Ensign** (Private Account), a stellar performer on the racetrack who swept through 13 straight victories without a defeat during her career, is proving equally successful in the breeding shed and was named the 1996 "Broodmare of the Year" by the Kentucky Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association. Now 13, the Ogden Phipps-bred Eclipse champion has produced five foals of racing age to date; all are winners and two, 1995 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies heroine **My Flag** (Easy Goer) and **Miner's Mark** (Mr. Prospector), have Grade I victories to their credit. Also honored at Wednesday's KTOB luncheon were the breeders of 1996 Kentucky-bred champions **Serena's Song** (Rahy), older female and Horse of the Year, bred by Dr. Howard Baker; W. S. Farish and Ogden Mills Phipps' **Storm Song** (Summer Squall), two-year-old filly; W. T. Young's **Boston Harbor** (Capote), two-year-old colt; Michael Fennesy's **Yanks Music** (Air Forbes Won), three-year-old filly; Georgia Hofmann's **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer), three-year-old colt; Mr. and Mrs. John Mabee's **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o'Gold), older male; John W. Phillips' **Memories Of Silver** (Silver Hawk), turf female; Issam M. Fares' **Da Hoss** (Gone West), turf male; Robert Sangster's **Lit de Justice** (El Gran Senor), sprinter; and Cyril Humphries' **Halling** (Diesis {GB}), Kentucky-bred racing abroad. Juddmonte Farms received the P.A.B. Widener Award for the breeder who produced the most Kentucky-bred stakes winners; D. **Isitingood** (Crusader Sword), former mile world record holder, will likely run next in the Texas Mile at Lone Star Park April 20. The veteran runner will face last year's champion three-year-old **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) in the race.

## WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES

### PEDIGREE SHORTS...

The cross of Danzig on Alydar mares has produced Grade I winners Lure and Strolling Along and Japanese Champion Yamanin Paradise. It now looks as if it works in reverse as the GII San Bernardino H. resulted in a triumph for the lightly-raced six-year-old **Benchmark (h, 6, Alydar--Winters' Love, by Danzig)**.

The Epsom Derby winner Quest For Fame has made a promising start with his first crop in Europe, Australia and New Zealand. Over the weekend, **Famous Digger (f, 3, Quest For Fame {GB}--Prospect Digger, by Mr. Prospector)** gave him his first North American stakes-winner when taking the Providencia S. at Santa Anita. Famous Digger is inbred 5x3 to Raise a Native through a son and a daughter, and, more unusually, has a double of Herbager's sire Vandale (Fr).

The combination of genetic relatives from the Lavendula (Fr) family just keeps on working. Winner of the North Miami Beach S. at Hialeah Sunday was **Lil's Golden Halo (f, 3, Jolie's Halo--Klassy Gem, by Klassy Flight)**. She is the first stakes-winner for her sire, who is inbred 3x4 to Turn-to, and in the pedigree of her dam we find Lavendula's son Ambiorix II, the half-brother to Turn-to's dam Source Sucree. A similar pattern is found in the pedigree of **Linesman (NZ) (g, 5, Touching Wood--Linecall (NZ), by \*Sir Tristram)**, who galloped off with the \$550,000 Sydney Cup (G1) Saturday. He is inbred 4x4 to Turn-to, but in the pedigree of Sir Tristram we also find My Babu, who like Turn-to, is a grandson of Lavendula, and who is out of Turn-to's close genetic relative Perfume II.

We have been wondering how Southern Halo, who is by Halo out of a Northern Dancer mare and inbred to Almahmoud, might work when he gets a male strain of Northern Dancer. The answer seems to be pretty well. Over the weekend, his two-year-old son **Handsome Halo (c, 2, Southern Halo--Helen Christine, by Northern Jove)** captured the G1 Gran Premio Santiago Luro. Handsome Halo has Northern Dancer 3x3 through a son and a daughter, and now that Southern Halo has been covering Northern Hemisphere mares we expect to see similar patterns succeed here in a few years time.
