PICK OF THE CROP: FAVORITES RULE IN DERBY PREPS

It was a day for the chalk players as the top picks in yesterday's GII \$700,000 Toyota Blue Grass at Keeneland, GII \$500,000 Wood Memorial at Aqueduct and GII \$500,000 Arkansas Derby at Oaklawn all came home winners. Redeeming himself after his loss in the GI Florida Derby, 2-5 Pulpit (A.P. Indy) spoke his mind with an authoritative score in the Blue Grass as his Florida Derby conqueror **Captain Bodgit** (Saint Ballado), 8-5, took command in the mud at Aqueduct for his second consecutive graded stakes triumph in the Wood Memorial; GIII Louisiana Derby winner **Crypto Star** (Cryptoclearance), a lukewarm choice at 5-2, headlined in his second straight graded race as well, shooting down the lane to grab the victory in the Arkansas Derby in the final yards. The rains came down in New York and it wasn't until the last minute that the connections of Captain Bodgit decided to run their colt in the Wood; reluctant to risk triggering tendon trouble, his trainer, Gary Capuano, waited until just before the 45-minute deadline to scratch before giving the thumbs-up. "The track is good--it's almost too fast," explained Capuano. "It's not the deep, pulling type of track--that's what I was afraid of for Captain Bodgit." And within the hour the bay proved the decision a wise one, sailing from sixth on what had been a speed-favoring track all day to win going away. "He is fit and ready," said Capuano. "Now all we have to do is keep him happy and healthy." The good Captain will again face arch rival Pulpit in the GI Kentucky Derby May 3 at Churchill Downs. Claiborne's homebred bay stalked **Jules** (Forty Niner) (fifth) through moderate fractions over a fast Keeneland strip, sweeping to the lead on the far turn and drawing away at will. "I don't think we've seen the best of him yet," said his trainer, Frank Brothers. "He is still on the upswing. He did well at Gulfstream, but he's done incredibly well here (in Kentucky)." Last year's Kentucky Derby winner Grindstone followed the Triple Crown trail through Louisiana and Arkansas before marching into the winner's circle at Churchill Downs; Team Crypto Star would like to follow suit. Their colorbearer had just one horse beaten after six furlongs but came flying at the finish to give trainer Wayne Catalano and jockey Pat Day reason to stop and smell the roses. "He makes you work hard but it's well worth it," said Day. "This colt just keeps coming and coming." (*Stakes Charts, p1-2*)

Making his first start since suffering his only career defeat when second in the GI Florida Derby March 15, Pulpit was bet down to 2-5 and justified those odds with an impressive performance. Racing on Lasix for the first time, the royally bred bay pressed **JULES** (Forty Niner) through three-quarters in 1:12.49 before galloping to the lead and stamping himself a Kentucky Derby contender. "(Trainer Frank Brothers) never tells me anything, but before I got up he told me, 'I want you to be a little more aggressive leaving there with this colt and you get running on his mind'," said winning jockey Shane Sellers. "And that's what I did. He put me in the game today." But looking toward that long mile-and-a-quarter on the first Saturday in May, he added, "I got my colt to get off the bridle and that's the best thing that has happened to him. He's learned to relax. I think that's going to make him a better horse." Acceptable, runner-up in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile but off the board his last two, made a run at the winner at the top of the stretch but couldn't close ground; he held off Stolen Gold for the place. "I think this is going to help his confidence level a great deal," said his rider, Craig Perret. "He's ready to run again and mentally wanting to fire. He's back on track." The top three will all be back in the "Run for the Roses" May 3.

Running against the track's bias towards speed, the late-closing Captain Bodgit came through with powerful closing kick to win going away in the slop at the Big A. Rated off the pace of Gotham winner Smokin Mel, the crowd's choice came off the rail for the stretch drive and outfinished Accelerator for a determined score. "I had perfect position throughout," said his jockey, Alex Solis. "At the five-sixteenth pole I asked him and he threw me into the back seat. He just keeps getting better and better." The first two finishers will meet again in the GI Kentucky Derby May 3, and trainer John DeStefano Jr. is also considering a run for the roses with Smokin Mel. "It sure would be nice to go," he said. ORDWAY (Salt Lake), second in the Gotham and the second favorite here, sat just off the pace early but had nothing left for the drive and ended up fourth. Trainer Dave Donk is still thinking Churchill. "I don't know if it's fair to say that he bounced coming back in just a couple of weeks (after the Gotham), but I'd say that we're probably still going to run in the Derby," he said.

Never off the board in six starts and looking for his second straight Derby win, Crypto Star bided his time near the back of the pack for six furlongs but finished full of run to edge Gill Rebel S. winner Phantom On Tour at the wire. The Kentucky-bred colt heads to Louisville next to try for "The" Derby win May 3. The runner-up shadowed pacesetter DIRECT HIT (Mamaison) through honest early fractions, took over three furlongs from home, but couldn't hold off the late charge of the winner. "He was a little anxious there, maybe too sharp," said his trainer, Lynn Whiting. "I wish he had relaxed more." Third-placed finisher Pacificbounty closed to second at the top of the lane but hung late and had to settle for third. "He's never hung before," said trainer Walter Greenman, but added, "We'll go on to Kentucky and maybe take a shot."

News cont.**OCTAGONAL'S FAREWELL ENDS IN DEFEAT**

Australia's great champion **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) came to the end of the racing road Saturday in Sydney, but, sadly, not in victory. On his final racecourse experience, the four-year-old colt was beaten a length and a quarter by the three-year-old colt **Intergaze (Aus)** (Integra {Aus}) in the G1 Queen Elizabeth S. over a mile and a quarter at Randwick. Octagonal, the 11-8 favourite, was chasing his fifth straight win and his 11th Group One success, but he could not catch the winner, himself now a triple Group One winner who was receiving seven pounds from the champion. Octagonal now retires to owners Jack and Bob Ingham's Woodlands Stud in New South Wales as the richest earner in Australian racing history with a total of \$4,663,789. Bob Ingham said: "It's a little disappointing that he didn't win, but he gave it his best, as he always does." Trainer John Hawkes was in fact somewhat relieved. "I'm glad it's over," he said. "It's a shame he couldn't go out on a winning note, but that's racing. He didn't have anything to prove today and it's great to see how the public responded to him." The crowd of 28,000 was up 10,000 from the average for Queen Elizabeth S. day.

HIALEAH CANCELS Racing was called off after the third event at Hialeah yesterday after heavy rains turned the Florida oval into a sea of slop, and jockeys and Hialeah officials agreed that the track condition had become unsafe. The scheduled feature, the GII Black Helen H., will now be run Saturday, April 19, with only those named in the field yesterday eligible for the race. Racing is expected to resume this afternoon.
