KENTUCKY DERBY '97: POST-PREP

WRAP-UP The first three finishers in all three Kentucky Derby preps held Saturday are now likely headed for Churchill Downs. Trainer Frank Brothers said his GII Toyota Blue Grass winner **Pulpit** (A.P. Indy) came back from the victory in good order and has returned to his base at the Louisville track to get ready for the first Saturday in May. Nick Zito, conditioner of Blue Grass runner-up **Acceptable** (Capote), said of his colt's Derby prospects, "We'll see how everything is the next couple of days, but everything looks positive." **Stolen Gold** (Conquistador Cielo), third at Keeneland, is also possible for the Derby. His owners, Al and Sandee Kirkwood, also campaign GI Santa Anita Derby third Hello (Ire), and are considering both for the main event. GII Wood Memorial winner **Captain Bodgit** (Saint Ballado) will ship from Aqueduct to Churchill tonight. "We want to get to Kentucky early and give him some time to get used to the track," said Barry Irwin, president of Team Valor. "Even the good ones don't breeze well the first time over it because they can take time to get used to it. There's only one Derby and you have to take every edge you can get." Final plans for Ogden Mills Phipps' **Accelerator** (A.P. Indy), second in the Wood, will be made in a day or two, but the colt came out of the race well and is likely to head to Louisville. **Smokin Mel** (Phone Order), third at the Big A, and **Ordway** (Salt Lake), fourth, are also potential Derby candidates. "I'll say I'm 50-50 to run in the Derby," said Dave Donk, trainer of Ordway. "If not, we may try the Preakness." The top three from the GII Arkansas Derby, **Crypto Star** (Cryptoclearance), **Phantom On Tour** (Tour d'Or) and **Pacificbounty** (Pirate's Bounty), respectively, all headed out of Oaklawn Sunday morning, bound for Kentucky.

Canadian champion three-year-old Victor Cooley, winner of the July 7 GIC Queen's Plate and runner-up in the Sept. 15 GI Woodbine Million at Woodbine, won his 1997 debut in a Feb. 17 allowance race and then ran sixth in the Mar. 23 Pelleteri Breeders' Cup H., both at the Fair Grounds. Making his third start of the season, the winner sat just off the pace while racing between horses before angling out into the stretch and just ran down Western Winter near the wire. "I had a beautiful trip," winning jockey Eddie Martin Jr. said. "My horse broke good. I had to let him settle a bit in the chute, but once we hit the main course I was in beautiful position. I was fifth, about two off the lead, almost at every pole. I was in a bit tight all the way, but I was always confident. I had a lot of horse under me." MGSW and favorite Appealing Skier set a pressured pace and weakened in the stretch. "The track's just a little slow," Mike Smith, rider aboard Appealing Skier, said. "It just didn't suit him today, but he ran a great race."

SOUTH AFRICAN CHAMP WINS IN HONG

KONG South Africa's champion **London News (SAf)** (Bush Telegraph {SAf}) became the first horse from his country to campaign overseas in 39 years and gave the racing and breeding industry back home a great boost when winning Sunday's Queen Elizabeth II Cup over a mile and a quarter at Sha-Tin in Hong Kong. Ridden by Dougie Whyte, the Alec Laird-trained four-year-old colt beat the locally-trained **Privilege (Ire)** (Last Tycoon {Ire}), last year's champion stayer in the country, by a half length; the Godolphin runner **Annus Mirabilis (Fr)** (Warning {GB}), with Frankie Dettori in the irons, was the same margin away in third. Laird was somewhat stunned by the victory, saying: "We have been out in the international racing wilderness for so long and I was a bit shocked by the win." London News, owned by Laurie and Jean Jaffee, carried top weight of 131 pounds while winning in a new track record time of 2:00.30 despite the rain-softened ground. He will now point for Australia's most prestigious Group One weight-for-age race, the W.S. Cox Plate over a mile and a quarter at Moonee Valley in Melbourne.

JULIE KRONE TO RIDE IN JERSEY Unable to keep pace with leading riders during recent meets at the New York tracks, jockey Julie Krone will return to Monmouth Park when the New Jersey oval opens May 24. Krone was the leading rider at Monmouth from 1987-89 and led the standings at the Meadowlands for four straight years beginning in 1987. She switched to the New York circuit full time in 1991 and was the leading rider at Belmont's spring meet in 1992; she also captured the 1993 Belmont S. with Colonial Affair. "I'm working hard, riding well and I'm healthy," said Krone. "I need to ride in every race every day and get back what I guess you'd call the magic. I want to ride the card and be leading rider at Monmouth." With Joe Bravo, the top jockey at Monmouth since 1991, headed to the Big Apple this spring, Krone hopes to step in and take over his spot in the standings.

SANTA ANITA MERGES WITH HEALTHCARE INVESTMENT TRUST The Santa Anita Companies, which oversees the operations at Santa Anita racetrack, and Meditrust, the nation's largest healthcare real estate investment trust, yesterday jointly announced the merger of the two entities. Upon completion of the merger, the paired-share company, to be called Meditrust Corporation, will be based in Needham, Massachusetts and listed on the New York Stock Exchange under the symbol "MT." Said Abraham D. Gosman, chairman of Meditrust, "We are fully focused on achieving enhanced shareholder value, as reflected in our strong financial performance, stock appreciation and 45 consecutive quarterly dividend increases. We plan to continue to expand our healthcare underwriting portfolio...moreover, we are pleased to be part of the tradition and heritage of Santa Anita and are committed to live racing at Santa Anita Racetrack." The transaction, already approved unanimously by the Boards of both companies, is subject to regulatory approvals and the approval of the shareholders of both Meditrust and The Santa Anita Companies.
