KEENELAND APRIL TWO-YEAR-OLD SALE

OPENS A total of 246 two-year-olds as well as 13 older horses, part of the late Jack Kent Cooke's Elmendorf dispersal, have been catalogued for the Keeneland April Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale, set for today and tomorrow in Lexington. The Elmendorf dispersal features four-year-old filly **Antespend** (Spend A Buck), a MGISW of nine races and \$865,399. Top sires such as A.P. Indy, Capote, Danzig, Deputy Minister, Gone West, Sadler's Wells, Seeking the Gold and Storm Cat will be represented by two-year-olds during the auction. Also offered are a full sister to multi-millionaire Mecke (Maudlin), and a half-sister, by Robyn Dancer, to last year's champion older mare Jewel Princess. The fastest times at the final under-tack preview, held yesterday, were, on dirt: one furlong - Hip #193, a colt by Caller I.D., :10 1/5; one quarter - Hip #232, a colt by Pine Bluff, :21 1/5; three furlongs - Hip #34, a colt by Copelan, :33 3/5; a half - Hip #248, a three-year-old colt by Key to the Mint, :47 1/5; and on turf: one quarter - Hip #139, a filly by Woodman, :21 2/5; and three furlongs - Hip #180, a colt by Easy Goer, :35 2/5. The sale begins at 6:30 p.m. daily. (*Complete times, p6-7*)

TODAY Tattersalls have catalogued 202 two-year-olds in training for their April Breeze-Up Sales, to be held at Park Paddocks in Newmarket, England today and Wednesday. "We believe this to be the best British Breeze-Up catalogue to be compiled so far, with a considerable number of world-class stallions represented," said Chairman Edmond Mahony. Thirty-eight of the stallions represented have already sired Classic or Group 1 winners, including Alzao, Bering (GB), Cadeaux Genereux (GB), Darshaan (GB), Indian Ridge (Ire), Last Tycoon (Ire), Night Shift, Nureyev, Polar Falcon, Royal Academy, Salse, Soviet Star and Warning (GB). News cont.**URBANE RETIRED** Millionaire mare **Urbane**

(Citidancer), winner of the GI Ashland S. at three and the GI John A. Morris H. at four, has been retired and will be bred this season to Gone West, according to a report in the *Daily Racing Form*. Now five, the Maryland-bred made what would be her final career start in the GI Spinster S. at Keeneland last October, finishing sixth; she goes to the breeding shed with a record of eight wins from 18 career starts and \$1,018,568 in earnings.

LONESOME GLORY TAKES CAROLINA CUP

Disappointing in two starts last fall after being honored as the champion steeplechaser in 1992, '93 and '95, **Lonesome Glory** (Transworld) rocketed back to the top of the jump world with an impressive victory in the GI \$110,600 Carolina Cup Saturday in Camden, South Carolina. The nine-year-old, racing on Lasix for the first time, bided his time just off the pace before moving to the leaders with three fences to go; he took over at the final jump and pulled away to best **Hudson Bay** (Northern Baby) by a length and a half. "I was riding him like it was two years ago, and he was relaxed and just carrying me along early in the race," said regular jockey Blythe Miller. "He goes out and tries his best for you--I'm glad to have him back." Added trainer Bruce Miller, "That's the best race he's run in three years and the toughest for me to win. I worry about shorter distance races because I don't know whether he can quicken like he does in the longer ones." **Lonesome Glory** covered the 2 1/4 miles of the Carolina Cup in 4:27 2/5; he now has 13 wins for earnings of \$617,632 in the U.S. Defending Eclipse Award champion **Correggio** (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) was scratched from the race midweek due to a cough.

RAKEEN GELDING WINS SOUTH AFRICAN

DERBY Northview Stallion Station's **Rakeen** (Northern Dancer) is the sire of Saturday's G1 South African Derby winner **North By Northwest**. The colt, from Rakeen's first crop, won the \$56,870 contest over 1 1/2-miles at Turffontein in Johannesburg; his trainer, David Ferraris, has now won the event for five straight years and dominated Saturday's running, saddling the winner, runner-up and fourth-place finisher. **North By Northwest**, who cost \$20,473 as a yearling, has now won five times from 10 starts for earnings of \$68,244. His sire Rakeen, out of Canadian Horse of the Year **Glorious Song**, is a half-brother to both **Rahy** and the recent Dubai World Cup winner **Singspiel** (Ire).

Despite breaking from the extreme outside post in the 18-horse field, Sunny Brian went right to the front. The colt lost his advantage passing the six-furlong marker but regained the lead four furlongs from home. Favored MEJIRO BRIGHT (JPN) (Mejiro Ryan {Jpn}) trailed the field as usual, but his late-running bid fell short and he finished fourth. Winning rider Naohiro Onishi said, "I was going to be a pacesetter from the beginning because this horse had made all the pace every time he won. I let him run as he liked and just hoped no one was coming in the final stretch. I felt that this stretch was the longest I'd ever ridden." Brian's Time was represented by the first two finishers in the race--the third year in a row a stallion has had the first two runners in the 2000 Guineas; Sunday Silence recorded the feat in 1995 and 1996.
