ACCEPTABLE OUT OF DERBY WITH FRAC-

TURE Acceptable (Capote), second in the Toyota Bluegrass last Saturday, suffered a condylar fracture in his left front leg yesterday and will miss the May 3 Kentucky Derby. The three-year-old completed a five-furlong work in 1:03 3/4 under jockey Willie Martinez on a muddy Keeneland track, but came back "off," according to trainer Nick Zito, who said that Dr. Larry Bramlage is scheduled to perform surgery on the colt today. "I see this every year," said Zito, "but it has never happened to me." Co-owned by Kinsman Stable and Three Chimneys Farm, Acceptable has won two of nine starts and earned \$400,020. Zito, with two Kentucky Derby wins under his belt already, still has two candidates for the first leg of this year's Triple Crown--Shammy Davis (Temperence Hill), entered in today's GII Lexington S. at Keeneland, and Jack Flash (Sovereign Dancer).

CONCERTO: NO SALE Rumors swirling around Pimlico Racecourse that Concerto (Chief's Crown), winner of yesterday's Federico Tesio S. (see p. 3) had been sold to an owner represented by trainer D. Wayne Lukas proved to be unfounded yesterday, but Lukas admitted that there had been some discussions with Concerto's owner, George Steinbrenner, involving a possible sale of the colt. "We talked with George at length and kicked it around," said Lukas. "At this point, we're not close to a deal." Lukas declined to reveal which of his owners was involved in the negotiations, only saying, "it was one of my major clients. These are very tough deals to put together. So much is involved." Maryland veterinarian Bob Vallance said that he was asked by veterinarian Robert Copelan to take X-rays of Concerto, and that Copelan had been expected to arrive at his Laurel barn by 1 p.m. to physically examine the colt. But Vallance said that Copelan, caught in traffic from Baltimore-Washington International Airport, did not arrive at the barn until 2 p.m., by which time Concerto had left for Pimlico to run in the Tesio.

BAILEY WINS 4000TH Hall of Fame jockey Jerry Bailey rode the 4000th winner of his career yesterday at Keeneland aboard Middleberg (GB) (Midyan) in the seventh race. Keeneland president Bill Greely presented Bailey with a silver julep cup in the winner's circle. "There have been some wonderful horses I've ridden and some great moments," Bailey said of his career. "I really wouldn't trade it for anything."

I didn't want to have my horse find himslf all alone and start to loafing. But he did okay. (Jockey) Carlos (Marquez Jr.) didn't have to ask much of him." Tammaro declined to comment on the possible sale of his colt (see p. 1).
