TRAPP MOUNTAIN COLT TOPS OBS FINALE

Mountain Top, a Trapp Mountain colt out of Turning Top (Turn to Mars) brought the highest price of the fourth and final session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's April Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training held yesterday. William Perry signed the \$87,000 ticket on behalf of John Murphy. The dark bay or brown colt, sold as hip number 964, was consigned by Lynne Martin, Agent VI, and is a half brother to MSW **Hooting Star** (Commadore). The final day's average dipped slightly from the corresponding session a year ago, down to \$15,270 from 1996's \$15,648, while the median increased from \$10,000 to \$11,000. Cecil Seaman, agent, was the sales leading buyer, signing for six lots totaling \$271,500. Seaman also bought the overall sale topper, hip number 540, a filly by Glitterman consigned by Michael Yates, agent, for \$125,000. The four-day sale grossed \$10,270,800. The average price of \$17,204 increased 11.2 percent from 1996's \$15,466, while the median price rose 23.8 percent from \$10,500 to \$13,000. "Overall, we're pleased with the way the week went," said OBS president Tom Chiota. "Demand was steady at all levels and the market rewarded the consignors who brought the best athletes. The buyers know this sale annually produces many outstanding race horses and came ready to buy." Next on the OBS schedule is the June Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training and Horses of Racing Age scheduled for June 9.

LOUIS QUATORZE INJURED Trainer Nick Zito reported that last year's GI Preakness S. victor **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer) came out of his 13-length romp in Wednesday's GIII Ben Ali H. with a small chip in his left front ankle. "Dr. (Larry) Bramlage will handle it and hopefully we'll have Louis back in the barn in six weeks," Zito said. Louis Quatorze, second in last year's Breeders' Cup Classic, took the GIII Creme Fraiche H. at Gulfstream March 15 by 4½ lengths. The Ben Ali H. was the four-year-old colt's second start of the year. To date, Louis Quatorze has started 18 times for seven wins and earnings of \$2,054,434.

GI Arkansas Derby runner-up **Phantom on Tour** (Tour d'Or) and Hall of Fame jockey Jerry Bailey teamed up for the first time yesterday morning. The pair worked seven furlongs in 1:26 over a fast track. Clockers caught the first quarter in :25 2/5, the half in :50 3/5, the three-quarters in 1:13 3/5 and out the mile in 1:41 3/5. "I thought he worked very well," said Bailey. "I thought he was very calm, took in everything well, relaxed the first part of it which was my concern."

Silver Charm (Silver Buck), runner-up in the GI Santa Anita Derby, worked six furlongs in 1:13 Thursday. Clockers caught the move in :24 1/5 for the quarter, :48 1/5 for the half, 1:01 2/5 for the five-eighths and out seven-eighths in 1:26 2/5. "I was looking for a hard work from him and I got it," trainer Bob Baffert said. Exercise rider Joe Steiner reported the colt, "felt like a million dollars just like he always does."
