**ACCELERATOR, ANET OUT OF DERBY** Ogden Mills Phipps' **Accelerator** (A.P. Indy) suffered a non-displaced lateral condylar fracture of the left front leg during a workout Friday morning and will miss the Kentucky Derby and at least two months of training. "It's disappointing," said trainer Shug McGaughey. "These things happen so fast you don't even have time to react. He'd been doing good. He was sound and I thought he deserved a chance to try." The colt had gone a quarter in :25 2/5 yesterday morning at Churchill Downs when exercise rider Cecil Putnam felt him take a bad step. He will be shipped to Rood & Riddle equine hospital in Lexington for surgery. "From the looks of his x-ray, his (fracture) should come together perfectly," said veterinarian Dr. Foster Northrop. "Sometimes, with fractures like these, the horse walks into the operating room lame and walks out sound." Lone Star Derby winner **Anet** (Clever Trick) will also miss the "Run for the Roses," according to trainer Bob Baffert. "It would be too much to ask of him," he said. "He has been off his feed and we are going to lighten up on him. You are going to have to be 100 percent to win this race, and he isn't 100 percent."

Gaines, chairman of the NTA Policy Board. "In light of the overwhelming response, the Board has decided for a period of time to welcome any others who want to be included as NTA Founding Members."

Chief Bearhart, winner of last year's GIC Breeders' S. at Woodbine by 9 1/2 lengths, ran second last time out in the Apr. 11 Gilll Maker's Mark Mile S. at Keeneland in his 1997 debut. The second choice raced just off the pace on the inside before swinging out three-wide in the stretch to run down Snake Eyes near the wire. "I started asking him the last half a mile," winning jockey Jose Santos said. "He was gaining some ground all the way around. I had a bit of traffic around the turn, but at the top of the stretch I came out to the outside nice and clear; he finished very strongly when I started hitting him, and he got the job done." Favored Lassigny came six-wide into the stretch to make his late bid but lacked a response in the final furlong. "He never really felt comfortable," said his jockey, Pat Day. "I was right with the eventual winner going past the half-mile pole...(but) he never carried me into the race at any point." Last year's Belmont S. winner EDITOR'S NOTE (Forty Niner), off at 10-1 in his grass debut, tracked the pace in third early but tired badly to finish a well-beaten seventh.

Winning trainer Roger Charlton said: "We struggled to keep Wixim going last year because he had trouble with his feet and was not suited by the firm ground. He had not run for nearly 11 months until he was beaten into second by Ali-Royal in last week's Earl Of Sefton S. at Newmarket. We were not keen to run him here, but there were no other suitable races for him for another two months. Pat (Eddery) said that the horse began to pull himself up when he got to the front, but then ran on again when First Island came up to challenge on the outside."

Trainer Bob Baffert has been selected as the recipient of the sixth Ambassador of Racing Award from Kentucky Thoroughbred Media. According to a report in yesterday's *Seattle Times*, Washington Governor Gary Locke has signed a bill which will allow the racetracks in his state to offer full-card simulcasting for the first time. During a live meet, the state's tracks can simulcast one full card on racing days and two full cards on dark days; during the off-season, tracks can offer up to five full cards, five days a week. Emerald Downs, now open for racing, plans to simulcast the action from Hollywood Park and Golden Gate, while Yakima Meadows and Playfair, not currently open, will offer racing from Churchill Downs, Emerald Downs, Golden Gate, Hollywood and Lone Star Park. The Washington Horse Racing Commission is expected to give final approval to the plan in a meeting Tuesday. The bill will also allow the Washington tracks to sell their simulcast signals out of state for the first time.
