KENTUCKY DERBY UPDATE Trainer D. Wavne Lukas, who had been expected to miss this year's Kentucky Derby after wining the last two and having a runner in each edition since 1981, is now leaning towards sending out his top filly Sharp Cat (Storm Cat) to run for the roses. Saying there are "more pros than cons" to running in the Derby, Lukas added, "I think the Prince (owner Ahmed Salman) would like to do it; (racing manager Richard Mulhall) doesn't." If Mulhall has his way, the filly, sixth in the GI Santa Anita Derby in her first try against colts, will run in the Kentucky Oaks May 2. Hello (Ire) (Lycius), third in the Santa Anita Derby last out April 5, had his final major Derby prep yesterday morning, working seven furlongs in 1:29 1/5. With jockey Calvin Borel in the saddle, the colt went his first quarter in :26 4/5, the half in :53 3/5 and six furlongs in 1:17; he went his final eighth in :12 1/5 and galloped out the mile in 1:43 1/5. "He went real good," said Borel. "As deep as (the track) was today, he finished well." Added trainer Ron McAnally, "This was juts a maintenance work. I wasn't looking for a whole lot because he's fit enough already." Chris McCarron will be aboard Saturday.

HOLLYWOOD OPENER SHOWS GAINS The opening night of the Hollywood Park spring/summer meeting, which began Friday, showed gains in both handle and attendance. A total of 32,581 fans came through the turnstiles, up 0.5 percent from the '96 opener, and the overall handle of \$8,332,225 was up 1.2 percent from a year ago. The 59th spring/summer season at "The Track of Lakes and Flowers" offers 33 stakes, 28 of them graded, for stakes purses of more than \$6.5 million. The highlight of the meeting is the GI \$1,000,000 Hollywood Gold Cup, second leg of the \$4.8 million MGM Grand Classic Crown, set for June 29. The mileand-a-quarter test will be run as a weight-for-age event for the first time in its history. Racing Wednesdays through Sundays, Hollywood will be open for a 66-day stand through July 21.

Looking for her second straight stakes win and her sixth victory from her last eight starts, the consistent Toga Toga Toga was made the 8-5 favorite by the Hollywood crowd and lived up to the backing. Reserved off the rapid early fractions set by 25-1 FINITE E.F. (Wolf Power {SAf}), the chestnut moved to challenge at the top of the stretch and finished fastest of all to win going away. "She is something else--so nice to ride, so professional," said winning jockey Gary Stevens. "She makes the job easy." Added her trainer, Eduardo Inda, "She's doing so good right now. Every time I worked her. I felt more and more confident. The track looked like it was favoring speed a lot today, but our filly is running too good." The 9-5 second choice CAT'S CRA-DLE (Flying Paster), with the pace early, was eased in the stretch. "She took a bad step around the turn," said her rider, Alex Solis, "After that, I had to pull her up because she felt a little funny. She just took a bad step. I think she's going to be all right." "She pulled up fine," said her trainer, David Hofmans. "After he stopped her, she looked pretty good. I don't know what the problem is, but we'll go back to the barn and look her over."
