**NYRA UNVEILS CASH-BACK PROGRAM** The New York Racing Association, looking to give something back to its regular customers, will initiate a program of cash and promotional rewards to NYRA One Account holders beginning with the opening of the Belmont Park spring season May 14. NYRA One Plus offers cash back to the biggest bettors at all three NYRA tracks--Aquaduct, Belmont and Saratoga--returning from 2 to 5 percent of money wagered for handicappers who bet at least \$10,000 per month. All account holders will earn points, based on one point per dollar bet on NYRA races only, which can be redeemed for prizes ranging from 10 tickets to the 1998 Belmont Stakes luncheon or a 27" color television to a \$25 gift certificate to the souvenir shop. Non-cash rewards can be earned by fans who bet at least \$10,000 per year. There is no minimum balance to open a NYRA One Account at the track; to access the account via telephone wagering, however, a minimum balance of \$450 required. "We want to create a program that will not only reward the larger players, but also our loyal, regular patrons who help support racing on a year-round basis," said NYRA President and Chief Operating Officer Terry Meyocks. "We're eager to see the response of our fans."

**SOUTH AFRICAN CHAMP TO ENGLAND** According to a report in Saturday's *Racing Post*, South African champion **London News (SAf)** (Bush Telegraph {SAf}), winner of Hong Kong's Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin earlier this month, is now headed for England and the stable of trainer William Haggas. "I am absolutely delighted to be getting a horse of this calibre in my yard," Haggas, who won the G1 Epsom Derby last year with Shaamit (Ire), told the *Racing Post*. "He is obviously a top-class horse and I am sure he will do very well in the UK." The four-year-old will ship from Hong Kong to England in approximately two weeks and point for the Prince Of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot in June; his regular South African rider, Douglas Whyte, will retain the mount.

An awesome performance from the 1996 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner Helissio, who, if all goes well, will now travel to England for the G1 Vodafone Coronation Cup over a mile and a half at Epsom on June 6.

Pilsudski's pacemaker TROJAN SEA (Bering {GB}) set solid early fractions with Helissio following in second. The winner took over the lead just over a half mile out; his move was shadowed by STRATEGIC CHOICE (Alleged) and Pilsudski, but the French champion was only toying with the field. On the turn he quickened brilliantly when asked by Olivier Peslier and soon put acres of daylight between himself and the chasing pack, going to the line under a hand ride only to win as easily as he liked. Le Destin, who had made good progress from the rear early in the straight, flew home to deprive Pilsudski of second. Winning trainer Elie Lellouche said: "I'm very happy and also very relieved, especially after the Dubai experience (the colt was scratched from the Dubai World Cup after it was postponed due to torrential rain). I wasn't at all sure about how to train him after that experience. That's what caused me the most anxiety and that's why I'm so relieved now. Helissio is still at his best and the Coronation Cup is next for him." Spanish owner Enrique Sarasola confirmed the plans for Epsom. "What a perfect way to start the season. Now we'll take him to England to show the English racing fans what Helissio is all about." Jockey Olivier Peslier added: "In my opinion he wasn't even 100 percent today and I was really surprised by his performance. I hadn't expected such a great show. He's even stronger than last year. As for Epsom, I see no reason why he won't be able to handle the track there."
