THIRTEEN DRAWN FOR 123rd DERBY Pulpit

(A.P. Indy), the 2-1 morning-line favorite for the Kentucky Derby, drew post position seven for Saturday's 123rd renewal of the historic race. Team Valor's **Captain Bodgit** (Saint Ballado), who handed Pulpit his lone defeat in the Florida Derby, was installed the second choice at 5-2 and will break from post position four. Team Valor president Barry Irwin was happy with the draw. "It's good," Irwin said. "Anything further inside would have been bad for us, but this looks good." Trainer Bob Baffert just missed winning last year's Derby with Cavonnier. He's back this year with GI Santa Anita Derby runner-up **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) who will break from post five Saturday. After the draw, Baffert said, "Someone had been asking me all week, what hole don't you want. And I didn't want to say it, because when you say it, that's the one you get. But, the *one* was the one and I'm just glad we didn't get the one hole." Trainer Ron McAnally, looking for his first Derby win, will be represented by **Hello (Ire)** (Lycius). After the Irish-bred colt drew the number eight post, McAnally said, "I think it's a great post position. Eight is a lucky number for me."

GARY STEVENS, EASY GOER ELECTED TO HALL OF FAME

Jockey Gary Stevens, who will bid for his third Kentucky Derby triumph this Saturday aboard Silver Charm, has been elected to the official National Thoroughbred Racing Hall of Fame. The announcement was made yesterday by John von Stade, president of the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame. Stevens, winner of the Run For The Roses in 1988 on Winning Colors and 1995 aboard Thunder Gulch, has won 20 percent of his graded stakes mounts and over 4,000 races to date. **Easy Goer**, this year's inductee in the category of modern male Thoroughbred, follows by one year the induction of his archrival, Sunday Silence. The son of Alydar was the Champion Two-Year-Old of 1988. He won 14 races, including the Belmont S., Champagne S., Wood Memorial, Travers, Woodward, Suburban and Jockey Club Gold Cup, for earnings of \$4,873,770. Other 1997 inductees include **Philip G. Johnson**, trainer of 80 stakes-winners; **Bold 'n Determined**, modern female Thoroughbred and winner of six Grade I races in 1980; and **Granville**, horse of yesterday and hero of the 1936 Belmont Stakes. This year's Hall of Fame induction will take place August 4 in Saratoga Springs, New York.

HOLY BULL DRUGGED BEFORE DERBY LOSS?

Was **Holy Bull** (Great Above) drugged in the days leading up to the 1994 Kentucky Derby? Owner and trainer Jimmy Croll thinks so. In a story in the *Los Angeles Times*, the Hall of Fame conditioner told racing writer Bill Christine that he is convinced his horse was drugged before the Derby. "They got to my horse," Croll said. "I know more than ever that Holy Bull was drugged." Did Croll really say that? Reached at his New Jersey home where he is preparing for the opening of the Monmouth meeting, Croll never denied saying Holy Bull was drugged. He did say, "I was shocked when I heard about the story being in the paper. I never meant for that to be written. I thought it was a private conversation. I would never say anything to embarrass the sport, especially at this time of the year." Croll told Christine that he was contacted by the FBI several months after the race and that the questions dealt with the race. The FBI in Kentucky declined to comment on whether there is an investigation into the Derby. Croll suspects someone gave Holy Bull halcion, a prescription drug used as a sedative. The trainer said his horse, "was sluggish a couple of days before the race and was sluggish on the day of the race. Looking back now I can see where there was a reason for that." The suspicions about halcion being used on Holy Bull came after Croll learned someone with access to his barn was investigated for having 4,000 halcion pills without a prescription. Croll refused to name the person and the Louisville Police Department could not clarify Croll's reference to an investigation centered on possession of large quantities of halcion.

ATTICUS TO THREE CHIMNEYS Alain and Gerard Wertheimer announced today that mile world record holder **Atticus** (Nureyev) will stand at Three Chimneys Farm in Midway, Kentucky in 1998. The five-year-old won seven of 18 career starts and ended his career with a win in the GI Oaklawn H. He retired with earnings of \$1,200,120. The stallion will be the property of a partnership between the Wertheimers and Robert Clay.
