### INSURANCE COMPANY TO KEEP CIGAR?

According to published reports, the insurance company which now owns **Cigar** (Palace Music) after paying off on the \$25 million fertility policy, will keep the stallion for now. The company will attempt to correct Cigar's problem and eventually return him to the breeding shed. Assicurazioni Generali SPA's Marketing Manager, David Dunnet, told the *Racing Post*, "We will be exploring all possibilities in an effort to get him back to stud and producing offspring." The *London Times* reports that Generali's bloodstock underwriter Peter Trend will travel to Kentucky before deciding what will be done next with the two-time Horse of the Year. "The first thing to do is to move Cigar away from the glare of publicity that he has been under of late," Trend told the *Times*. "We hope that the vets will be able to find an answer and that Cigar will be able to sire foals, in due course."

### KEENELAND WAGERING TOPS \$100 MILLION

Wagering topped \$100 million for the first time during Keeneland's 16-day spring meeting which ended Friday, April 25. Betting totaled a record \$101,966,368, a 2.9 percent increase from the previous high of \$99,072,764 established during last year's 15-day meet. On-track wagering totaled \$21,408,993, a seven percent increase from \$20,003,340 last year. The average daily handle was \$1,338,062, up .3 percent from \$1,333,556 in 1996. The spring meeting attracted 199,443 people to Keeneland, down two percent from 203,694 in 1996. Average daily attendance, 12,465, dropped 8.2 percent from 13,579 last year. Willie Martinez led the jockey standings with 23 wins and Nick Zito took leading trainer honors with 10 victories. Sam-Son Farm was the meet's leading owner with six wins.

**Phantom On Tour** (Tour d'Or) blew out for the Derby yesterday, going three-eighths in :35 3/5 and galloping out the half in :48 4/5. "I'm very happy with the way he went," said jockey Jerry Bailey, aboard for the move. "He was spunky and full of himself, which is what I wanted to feel." Trainer Lynn Whiting, concerned because his colt had been less than sharp the last few days, had blood drawn from his Derby hopeful yesterday and might have him tested again today, to make sure that he is in top health for Saturday's big event. "We'll continue to monitor the horse closely and work with him," he said, but added, "We were very pleased with what we saw today."

**CAT'S CRADLE RETIRED** Cat's Cradle, eased in the stretch of last Saturday's GII A Gleam H. at Hollywood Park, has been retired from racing after suffering a right front suspensory injury. Trainer David Hofmans reported the five-year-old mare will leave Hollywood Park Friday for Chance Farm in Lexington, Kentucky and will be bred to either Seattle Slew or Capote. Cat's Cradle won the 1995 GI Acorn S. and GII Fantasy S. in her 26-race career. She was on the board in 20 of those starts, winning ten and earning \$807,808.

**BONUS FOR FLYING CHEVRON'S FIRST GISW** Glencrest Farm announced yesterday that they will offer a \$300,000 bonus to the breeder of the first North American Grade I stakes winner from the first crop by **Flying Chevron** (Carson City), through that crop's four-year-old season. A winner of five of his seven starts, including the GI NYRA Mile, Flying Chevron stands as the property of a partnership for a fee of \$7,500, live foal.

### Local News: Australia

Top Australian runner **Nothin' Leica Dane (Aus)** (Danehill), winner of the 1995 Victoria Derby and runner-up in the Melbourne Cup in 1996, is being shipped to France with an eye towards this year's Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, according to a report in yesterday's *Racing Post*. John Hammond will handle the five-year-old's training.

### Local News, Singapore:

The Singapore Turf Club is building a new racecourse at Kranji, and the racing surface at Southeast Asia's newest facility will be made of materials developed in Britain. A 1 1/4 mile in circumference, Kranji will be constructed using 'Advanced Turf,' a sand and rootzone combination reinforced with mesh elements developed by the Blackburn-based company Netlon Ltd. in England. Netlon mesh element reinforced materials have been installed at a number of racetracks internationally, including Sha-Tin and Happy Valley in Hong Kong, and at Moonee Valley in Australia. The Singapore track is scheduled to open in 1999.
