SECOND TIME'S "THE CHARM" IN THE 123RD KENTUCKY DERBY Trainer Bob

Baffert saw Captain Bodgit (Saint Ballado) coming to his Silver Charm (Silver Buck) as the two drove down that interminable Churchill Downs stretch vesterday afternoon and begged, "Not again." Flash back to the first Saturday in May, 1996, as Baffert's Cavonnier loses the 122nd Kentucky Derby by a hair's breadth after a last desperate lunge by the late-running Grindstone; for just a moment, it looked like the nightmare might continue for the silver-haired horseman, but Silver Charm held on gamely to get the better of favored Captain Bodgit and win this year's "Run for the Roses" by a head, "When they came down the stretch, I thought `Oh, no, it can't happen again.' I thought I might have to do the low crawl out of here. But it was my turn this year--and the Lewises (owners Bob and Beverly), it was their turn, too. You have to be so lucky, and we were so lucky," said Baffert. Santa Anita Derby winner Free House (Smokester) bounced out of the gate on top, but Blue Grass hero Pulpit (A.P. Indv) soon took over and it was those two fighting it out until they hit the quarter pole. That's when Silver Charm, sitting pretty just off the leaders on the far outside, made his move, sweeping past the pacesetters and running all out to the wire to give jockey Gary Stevens his third Derby victory in the last 10 years. "This is a dream come true," said Stevens. "I had a dream trip. When he made the lead, he threw his ears up and was looking for some more competition. (Captain Bodgit) got up to within a head, and he stuck his ears back again and dug down deep; he gave it all he had. Nobody was going to get by him." The Captain, ninth early, took up the battle from the center of the track as the crowd of 141,981 (fourth largest in Derby history) took up the cheer, but despite having dead aim on the winner he was doomed to become the Derby's 18th consecutive losing favorite. "I swung him out at the quarter-pole and he fired," said his jockey, Alex Solis. "At the eighth pole, I thought we were the winner...but when (Silver Charm) saw me, he shifted into another gear. But my horse is still a champion in my heart, and there will be other days." Next on the calendar is the second leg of the Visa Triple Crown Challenge, the GI Preakness S. at Pimlico May 17.

Runner-up to Free House in both the San Felipe S. and Santa Anita Derby in his last two starts, Silver Charm proved those performances nothing more than dress rehearsals as he took center stage at Churchill Downs with a gallant victory in the 123rd running of the Kentucky Derby. The second choice in the 13-horse field, the grey was third after six furlongs in 1:12 1/5 and a mile in 1:37 1/5, but picked up pacesetters PULPIT (A.P. Indy) and Free House as they neared the eighthpole and then outfinished favored Captain Bodgit in the final yards. "I learned a lot about this colt in the Santa Anita Derby," said winning jockey Gary Stevens, who also took the roses with Winning Colors in 1988 and Thunder Gulch in 1995. "I gained new respect for him and I learned what his capabilities were. I felt like we lost the battle in the Santa Anita Derby but we came back and we won the war today. I had a lot of confidence that this colt was going to be dead fit today. I'll tell you what, coming back after the race, he wouldn't have blown out a match." Captain Bodgit just missed in a fine effort, while Free House was easily third and Pulpit just held on for fourth. "I didn't expect to be on the lead early," said David Flores, rider of Free House. "He responded when I asked him turning for home, but those other two horses were too strong." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas saddled DEEDS NOT WORDS (Rubiano) to a last-place finish after winning the last two Derbies, but all was not lost for owners Michael Tabor and Mrs. John Magnier; their Entrepreneur (GB) won yesterday's 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. On only the fourth start of his career and his first outing this year, the 11-2 second favourite Entrepreneur (GB) lived up to all the pre-race 'hype' and gave trainer Michael Stoute his third 2000 Guineas and jockey Michael Kinane his second victory in the race. He was quickly out of the gate and settled behind early leaders SHII-TAKE (GB) (Deploy {GB}) and STARBOROUGH (GB) (Soviet Star). Inside the final half-mile Starborough led from Entrepreneur, with Poteen making good ground, but the winner hit the front a guarter-mile out and he ran on strongly, holding the fast-finishing 100-30 favourite Revoque (Ire), who was slowly into his stride, comfortably. Entrepreneur is now even-money favourite with most bookmakers for the Vodafone Epsom Derby on June 7, in which he is expected to meet Revoque again. Kinane, who won the 2000 Guineas on Tirol in 1990, said: "I had to make a bit more use of him than I really wanted to, but after halfway the field moved towards the rail, so I kicked up and got in there. He cruises so well and is bred to get a mile and a half. I think he will improve." Winning trainer Michael Stoute said: "My team and the jockey have done a good job. We've always thought a lot of this horse. We wanted to run him in the G1 Dewhurst S. last October after he ran at Chester last year, but he coughed slightly and we were disappointed that he couldn't do that. For a Sadler's Wells horse with his pedigree, he has got more speed than you would expect. From the time we started working this horse, he exuded class and we've always been excited about him. He is brimful of promise, but it is early days." While the top two head for the Epsom Derby, third-placed finisher Poteen now heads for Royal Ascot and the G1 St. James' Palace S. on June 17.

Always A Classic won the Feb. 11 Mardi Gras H., a Mar. 13 off-the-turf allowance race and the Mar. 29 GIII Explosive Bid H. on the turf, all at the Fair Grounds. The winner, sent off as the second choice, relaxed while setting the pace and held the challengers at bay in the stretch. "It was as easy as it looked," winning rider Jerry Bailey said. "It looked like we would inherit the lead. He went along easy and when I asked him in the stretch, he gave me the right answer." Grade I winner and favorite Labeeb (GB), winner of the Apr. 5 Gll El Rincon H, at Santa Anita last time out to run his American record to four-for-four, tracked the winner while racing third and made a late bid but could not surge to the front. "They told me not to go too early," said his rider, John Velazquez. "I was just following orders. I rode him cautiously, not wanting to make any mistakes. That's not a good way to ride and it wasn't my best ride for sure. But I think if I would have moved him when I wanted to, he would have won the race."
