CAPTAIN BODGIT MAY SKIP PREAKNESS Kentucky Derby winner Silver Charm is considered a definite starter, but the Captain Bodgit camp was wavering on its next step. Though many expect that Team Valor, the syndicate that owns the colt, won't be able to resist the temptation of the Preakness, syndicate head Barry Irwin said yesterday that the Derby runner-up might pass the second leg of the Triple Crown in order to be better prepared for the June 7 Belmont S. "We're not sure we're going there (the Preakness)," Irwin said, "We'll take a good look at it and I know the trainer (Gary Capuano) will be under severe pressure to run there. We think he'll be unbelievable in the Belmont, so we have to think about that, whether we run in the Preakness or not. We want to have him around for a while, so we don't want to beat him up for the sake of some action." Irwin said his decision would be made by the beginning of next week, which will give him enough time to monitor the colt's condition. Free House (Smokester), third in Saturday's race is probable for the Preakness, while fellow Derby starters Pulpit (A.P. Indy) (4th), Crypto Star (Cryptoclearance) (5th) and Jack Flash (Sovereign Dancer) (7th) are considered possible starters in the second leg of the Triple Crown, Non-Derby starters listed as probables for the Preakness are Frisk Me Now (Mister Frisky), GII Lexington S. winner Touch Gold (Deputy Minister), GII Gotham runner-up Ordway (Salt Lake) and GI Futurity winner Traitor (Cryptoclearance).

#### RECORD SIMULCAST WAGERING ON DERBY

Preliminary simulcast wagering reports on the 123rd Kentucky Derby show the race established a record of \$51,237,397 at 1,020 sites throughout North America and the Caribbean. Common pool wagering was \$46,642,784, with separate pool accounting for \$4,594,613. The number of outlets was also a record, up from 966 sites that took part in the 1996 Kentucky Derby. Simulcast wagering on the '96 Derby was \$47,387,442.

Living up to the great promise which she had shown as a juvenile and putting her disappointing last effort firmly behind her, Sleepytime gave trainer Henry Cecil his fifth 1000 Guineas victory and new stable jockey Kieren Fallon his first Classic success with an outstanding victory Sunday. Settled towards the rear of the field while Oh Nellie cut out the early running, Sleepytime began to make up ground along the rail at halfway and, with Fallon getting a perfect run through the field, came through to grab the lead a furlong out, splitting Oh Nellie and Dazzle and going on to an easy success. Cecil, who had won the fillies' Classic with One In A Million, Fairy Footsteps, Oh So Sharp and last year with Bosra Sham, said: "She won like a good filly. We might try her at a mile and a quarter, but I think it is very doubtful she'll go for the Oaks. She's a very good miler at the moment. She always works like a very good filly, but she needs a strong pace and a nice clear run, which she didn't look like she was going to get today." Fallon, a 32-year-old Irishman said: "Sleepytime did a fantastic piece of work after her disappointing run in the Fred Darling S. at Newbury. It is brilliant to win a Classic. There will be celebrations tonight." The 50-1 outsider Oh Nellie gave owner Michael Tabor a weekend to remember after his Entrepreneur won Saturday's 2000 Guineas. Freddie Head said of his mount, favored PAS DE REPONSE (Danzig) (4th): "I'm obviously disappointed as she was going so well. She hadn't settled early on, but then came back on the bridle really well. When she hit the rising ground, she just went to a walk."

Langfuhr won the Sept. 21 Gl Vosburgh S. at Belmont and then ran eighth in the Oct. 26 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. The winner finished second last time out in the Apr. 20 GIC Vigil H. at Woodbine in his 1997 debut. The second choice was reserved early before advancing four-wide on the outside around the far turn and just ran down pacesetting Stalwart Member in the final strides. "He was real sharp today and he handled the track very well," winning jockey Jorge Chavez said. "He usually doesn't break well from the gate but today he broke out good. Late in the race, I wasn't too sure that he had enough to win, but when I saw the leader starting to tire out I felt that I had some run left, and I really got into him." Assistant trainer Robert Martin indicated that the winner may start next in the GI Metropolitan H. at Belmont on May 26. The 4-5 favorite Elusive Quality tracked the early leaders and showed no response in the stretch. "Today, he never took hold and showed no enthusiasm," jockey Pat Day said of the favorite. "I encouraged him, and I wasn't able to get anything out of him. He got over the track OK, he just didn't extend himself. There really was no plausible excuse that I could think of."


