SURGERY FOR PULPIT Pulpit (A.P. Indy), fourth in Saturday's GI Kentucky Derby, was scheduled to undergo surgery yesterday for removal of a small chip in his left knee. Dr. Larry Bramlage performed the arthroscopic operation at Lexington's Rood and Riddle equine hospital. Explaining how the chip was discovered, owner/breeder Claiborne Farm's Dell Hancock said, "There was a little bit of heat in (the knee); Frankie (Brothers) is very meticulous about everything, so he had the X-ray taken and there it was. It's bad news, but it explains why he didn't fire at the quarter-pole. We sure would hope that he can run again, but you have to be cautious when you make estimates on something." Added the colt's trainer, "I feel the chip significantly hampered Pulpit's performance in the Derby. He's proven he's a wonderful horse, and I look forward to his return." Now a winner of four of his six career starts and \$728,200, the three-year-old will have two weeks stall rest and three weeks hand-walking before a plan for his return to training is mapped out.

REVOQUE FOR THE IRISH 2000 GUINEAS In the immediate aftermath of his defeat in Saturday's Pertemps 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, all talk was of a re-match between Robert Sangster's race favorite **Revoque (Ire)** (Fairy King) and his conqueror **Entrepreneur (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) in the Vodafone Epsom Derby on June 7. However, trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam said Monday: "We have made no decision about whether or not Revoque will run in the Derby and will not do so for a while. He has come out of the Guineas well and the plan is to send him to The Curragh on May 25 for the Lexus Irish 2000 Guineas. We will then see how he works over further than a mile before making a decision about Epsom."

Local News: South Africa

It was reported in South Africa Monday that the country's champion racehorse **London News (SAf)** (Bush Telegraph {SAf}), winner of last month's Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup against an international field at Sha-Tin in Hong Kong, will not, after all, be joining the Newmarket stable of William Haggas when he arrives in Britain later this week. Instead he will go to Lambourn to be trained by Barry Hills. London News' owners Laurie and Jean Jaffee have made this decision following a call from Haggas, who informed them that several of his horses have been running poorly recently and he felt that there might be a virus in his stable and therefore it would not be fair to take the four-year-old colt into his care at present. The Jaffees still hope to see their champion run in the G2 Prince Of Wales S. over a mile and a quarter at the Royal Ascot meeting June 17.

Local News: Sam Houston Race Park

Sam Houston's spring meet ended Sunday, showing gains in the daily average handle on its simulcasting signal, on-track on its live card and on-track on both live and simulcast racing. The Houston oval averaged \$1.17 million per day on its live racing at simulcasting outlets, up 6 percent from 1996; the total daily average wagered on the live card, both on and off-track, was \$1.32 million, up 14 percent from last year's spring meet; and the total daily average handle, including all wagering on the live card and on simulcasting signals at Sam Houston, was \$1.64 million, an increase of 9 percent from a year ago. The "Horse of the Meet" was **Political Whit** (Lines Of Power), a three-time stakes winner during the 78-day stand. Ted Gondron led the riders with 69 wins; Amos Laborde won his third training title with 30 victories; and Israel Flores was the top owner with 10 wins.
