**ORDWAY OUT OF PREAKNESS** Last year's GI Moet Champagne S. winner **Ordway** (Salt Lake), second in the GII Gotham S. and most recently fourth in the GII Wood Memorial April 12, will miss the second leg of the Triple Crown after injuring his right hind leg during Thursday morning's six-furlong breeze. The colt suffered a curb, straining a ligament in his hock; he will be pin-fired. "He was favoring the leg this morning," said trainer Dave Donk. "It's not career-threatening, but he's not going to be racing for a while. It's too bad--he breezed really good yesterday."

**EIGHT-YEAR-OLD WINS OFF FIVE-YEAR LAYOFF** **Business is Boomin** (Businessisbusiness) won the seventh race at Garden State Park Thursday night, exactly five years to the day of his previous start. Trainer Michael Dickinson saddled the eight-year-old Thursday and fans expressed their confidence in the duo by making the gelding the 6-5 favorite in the mile-and-70-yard turf event for \$15,000 claimers. They were rewarded with a 6 3/4-length win. Business is Boomin won one race at two; Dickinson said he acquired the horse at three. He made his last start May 8, 1992, finishing second in an allowance at Belmont Park. "Twice since then, we got within a week of a race," said the trainer. "We booked Jerry Bailey once and John Velazquez another time, and as soon as we booked them, he bowed a tendon." In those five years, why didn't he ever give up? "Joan (Wakefield, Dickinson's assistant) loves him," he said. "She is his pet." What's next? "He'll run again in three weeks' time at Belmont, Pimlico or Delaware if his tendon is alright," said Dickinson. "If it's not alright, he'll come to live on our farm and spend the rest of his years as our pet."

Trainer Ken McPeek is putting blinkers on **Tejano Run** (Tejano) for his fifth start of the season. The five-year-old was third in the GI Oaklawn H. in his latest outing April 5. "I thought it was time to try and take him to another level," said McPeek, explaining the equipment change. "I think this will help him concentrate." The 1995 Kentucky Derby runner-up has started at Pimlico once before, running ninth in the '95 Preakness. He has won two of his four starts since returning from a nearly nine-month layoff February 16, taking a Gulfstream allowance by 10 3/4 lengths in his first try back and the GIII Widener H. at Hialeah March 22. **Key Of Luck** (Chief's Crown), fourth in the Dubai World Cup last out, makes his third start since running second in this event last year. **Skip Away** (Skip Trial), second in last year's Preakness over this track, tries to rebound from a lackluster third-place finish in the Texas Mile at Lone Star Park April 20.
