GENTLEMEN PULLS OFF THE GLOVES

IN PIMLICO SPECIAL There was nothing courteous about the way Gentlemen (Arg) (Robin des Bois) fought off Skip Away (Skip Trial) at the finish of yesterday's GI \$600,000 Pimlico Special. Making his first start since running third in the GI Santa Anita H. March 2, the five-year-old was as tough as they come despite the two-month layoff, turning back the challenge of last year's champion three-year-old to take a half-length victory as the crowd's 9-5 favorite. The South American sensation had put together five straight wins, four of them in graded stakes, before finishing behind stablemates Siphon (Brz) and Sandpit (Brz) in the Big 'Cap, but he rebounded after the short break, tracking pacesetter Isitingood (Crusader Sword) (fourth) through six furlongs in 1:10 before taking command, and then outgaming Skip Away to the wire under lockev Garv Stevens. "He really started giving me his all from the three-sixteenths pole," said Stevens. "My horse gave me a run today that he has not shown in his previous races. He's at the top of his game right now." Added trainer Richard Mandella, "I think this is one of the finest horses we've seen in a long time." Gentlemen will take on Skip Away once again in his next start, the GIII MassCap at Suffolk Downs May 31.

ARLINGTON INTERNATIONAL OPENS TODAY

Arlington International Race Course, which first opened in 1927, celebrates 70 years of racing when it opens for its 1997 meeting this afternoon. The Arlington Heights oval will feature a 24-race stakes program, highlighted by the International Festival Sunday, August 24, when the card will include the \$400,000 GI Secretariat S., \$500,000 GI Beverly D. and \$1,000,000 GI Arlington Million. The track will also host seven Grade II and seven Grade III events, offering more than \$4.2 million in stakes purses. New on the Arlington wagering menu this season will be the Pick Six and the Rolling Daily Double; the track also introduces "Two In The Money," where a bettor can pick any two horses to finish in the money in any order; "Match Rival," pitting any two horses, trainers or jockeys head-to-head; and "The Countdown," a Pick Four where you must select the fourth-place finisher in the first leg, the third-place finisher in the second, the runner-up in the third and the winner of the fourth race in the bet. First post is 1:05 p.m., CDT this afternoon. The Arlington meet runs through October 10.

Sixth in his U.S. bow last June, Gentlemen (Arg) then reeled off five consecutive victories, taking the GIII Bay Meadows H. and GII Citation H. on turf and the GIII Native Diver H. and GII San Antonio H. on dirt. Highweight at 123 pounds while trying 10 furlongs for the first time in the GI Santa Anita H. in his latest, the chestnut pressed the pace but weakened to be third to his Brazilian stablemates Siphon and Sandpit. Given a short vacation after the effort, Gentlemen had worked well for this start and ran back to those trials, pressing ISITINGOOD (Crusader Sword) through solid fractions before moving to the lead on the far turn and holding off the late charge of a rejuvenated Skip Away at the wire. "This horse was ready to run his race today," said trainer Richard Mandella. "He's been training very well. It's nice to see that he doesn't need to open up and be in front. We expect him to do great things." As for the runner-up, a lackluster third in the Texas Mile at Lone Star Park last out, jockey Shane Sellers said, "He's back to his old self. We were getting to (Gentlemen) some at the wire. We'll get him next time."
