BARRETTS SPRING SALE STARTS TODAY Bidding for the 1997 Barretts Spring Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training begins this afternoon at the Hinds Pavilion in Pomona, California, with the first of two sessions opening at 2 p.m. PDT. A total of 380 twoyear-olds have been catalogued for the auction, with top sires such as A.P. Indy, Caerleon, Capote, Deputy Minister, Gone West, Lyphard, Miswaki, Storm Bird and Unbridled represented. Also on offer is a filly by Beau Genius, a half-sister to MGISW and millionaire turf specialist Diplomatic Jet (Roman Diplomat); a filly by Seattle Dancer, a half-sister to MGSW and 1995 Kentucky Derby runner-up Tejano Run (Tejano); a colt by Wild Again out of GISW Sugar and Spice, a fullbrother to GSW Cinnamon Sugar (Ire); and a colt by Kris S., the first foal out of Canadian champion Avant's Gold. Previews for the sale were held Saturday and Sunday at Fairplex Park; Hip#32, a filly by In Excess (Ire), and Hip#290, a filly by Salt Lake, were clocked in the fastest one-furlong breezes, each posting identical times of :10.09; Hip#249, a filly by Phone Trick, topped the quarter-mile workouts, going in :21.23; and Hip#340, a colt by Pentelicus, was the quickest at three furlongs, getting the distance in :33.55. The two-day event concludes tomorrow, with the bidding again beginning at 2 p.m. PDT.

The Aga Khan's colt Daylami (Ire) had appeared to be fortunate to beat Loup Sauvage in the Prix de Fontainebleau last time out, but here there was no question about his French 2000 Guineas win. BAHA-MIAN BOUNTY (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) and YALAIETANEE (GB) (Sadler's Wells) disputed the lead from the start, with Daylami settled at the rear. On the final turn Yalaietanee tried to quicken, but he was soon headed by Loup Sauvage and Visionary (Fr); Daylami was only biding his time and he soon came to take command and storm clear for an easy win. Winning trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said: "That was really nice. He is undoubtedly my best three-year-old. He always races too keen when he is amongst a group of horses, so we get him to relax in behind. He can really quicken well, as he showed today." The Aga Khan was present and said: "Daylami is a pretty useful horse. When there is a strong pace, it helps him to settle. Our only worry today was how he would handle the soft ground. When he disappointed in the Criterium de Saint-Cloud last year the ground was soft and he hung badly. But he is stronger this year. I am sure he can get a mile and a quarter. No doubt there will be pressure to run him in the Epsom Derby, but it is a big step to ask him to go from a mile straight to a mile and a half, so it is more likely he will stay at a mile and go for the St. James' Palace S. at

Royal Ascot, or the (10-furlong) Eclipse S. in July."

A sixth win for French trainer Criquette Head and a seventh for her brother, jockey Freddie Head, in this French Classic as Always Loyal, winner last time of the G3 Prix de la Grotte and still unbeaten in her three career starts, battled hard for her victory. Red Camellia (GB) set a good pace and quickened on the final turn, but she was soon challenged by Seebe and Always Loyal on the outside. In a close finish, Always Loyal, who had seemed beaten a furlong out, came back to get up and take the photo from head Seebe. Her trainer said: "This filly is really brave. She fought hard to win-she wouldn't give in. This is very encouraging, as this was only her third start. Her last race did her a lot of good, as it taught her how to battle. I think she might stay more than a mile, so perhaps she will go for the Prix de Diane (French Oaks, at a mile and a guarter) or stay at a mile for the Coronation S. at Royal Ascot (June 18)." Winning owner Sheikh Maktoum al Maktoum, eldest brother of the Maktoum family and ruler of Dubai, donated the winner's prize money to charity. Ian Balding, trainer of Seebe, said: "She ran a smashing race. She surprised me by handling the very soft ground so well. She may go for the Irish 1000 Guineas next or for the Coronation S." Jean Lesbordes, trainer of disappointing favourite MOUSSE GLACEE (FR) (Mtoto {GB}), who had been a fast-finishing runner-up in the Prix de la Grotte, was inclined to blame apprentice jockey Vincent Vion for his filly's poor run, saying: "He lacks experience in big races like this. He had her on the outside for too long and she never relaxed. She will have a different jockey when she goes for the Prix de Diane."
