HELISSIO SIDELINED French trainer Elie Lellouche confirmed Monday at Chantilly that **Helissio (Fr)** (Fairy King), winner of last year's Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and first in the G1 Prix Ganay in his lone start this year, will miss the much-anticipated clash with Dubai World Cup winner **Singspiel (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}) in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom on June 6. "Helissio has had a high temperature and been a sick horse for the past week," said Lellouche. "We have given him box rest and only the occasional walk around the stable. We need several weeks to get him ready for another race, so, unfortunately, the Coronation Cup is out and we will now aim him for the (G1) Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud on June 29."

BRANSTON ABBY DEAD **Branston Abby (Ire)** (Risk Me {Fr}), who won more races during her career than any British-based mare in modern times, had to be put down Monday afternoon after contracting grass sickness late last week. The eight-year-old, who was in foal to Mark Of Esteem (Ire), had been sent to Rossdale's Veterinary Surgery in Newmarket, England but failed to respond to treatment. A champion in Germany, the 11-time stakes winner captured 22 of her 89 lifetime starts while racing in England, France and Germany for earnings of \$442,384; she was also Group-placed in Italy, and finished second in the G1 Haydock Park Sprint Cup in 1995. "I can only say what has been said before," said her trainer, Mark Johnston. "Her record speaks for itself. She was one of the bravest and she always gave of her best. It's a sad loss."

CORREGGIO GALLOPS IN '97 DEBUT Last year's champion steeplechaser **Correggio (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who went four-for-four en route to his Eclipse Award, came back after a six-month layoff to take Saturday's G1 Iroquois Steeplechase in Nashville, Tennessee by nine lengths. The six-year-old, winner of the Breeders' Cup Grand National and Colonial Cup last season, led every step, with **Lonesome Glory** (Transworld), champion in '92, '93 and '95, second. "He's just got that great gallop that other horses can't seem to match," said winning jockey Arch Kingsley. "I took a peek over my shoulder at the third-last fence...I knew it was going to take a lot of horse to catch us." Correggio had been scheduled to return in the Carolina Cup April 12, but missed the race due to a cough. He will now be rested until the Smithwick Steeplechase at Saratoga July 31.

PREAKNESS S.-GI, \$500,000, 3yo, 1 3/16m

Kentucky Derby winner **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) breezed five furlongs in 1:01 3/5 yesterday at Pimlico. "He's ready," said trainer Bob Baffert. "He doesn't need too much. I just wanted him to go an easy five-eighths, get him used to the track, see how he handled it. You just want to keep him happy."

Five Preakness hopefuls are slated to work this morning: Derby runner-up **Captain Bodgit** (Saint Ballado), third-place finisher **Free House** (Smokester), GII Lexington S. winner **Touch Gold** (Deputy Minister), **Frisk Me Now** (Mister Frisky) and **Concerto** (Chief's Crown).

Cryp Too (Cryptoclearance), runner-up in the GII Withers at Belmont Park last out May 3, has joined the field for the second leg of the Triple Crown. The New York-bred gelding is scheduled to arrive from his base at Suffolk Downs this afternoon. "He worked a strong seven furlongs in 1:28 here Sunday," said his trainer, Allen Borosh. "The track at Suffolk is deep and slow--it was probably like going in about 1:25 at Pimlico. He galloped out a mile in 1:41. We were between running in the Peter Pan (Sunday at Belmont) or the Preakness, but after looking at the field, and the fact that he's training so well, I decided to go for the big race."

Taiki Blizzard had been off since finishing a disappointing 13th in the Breeders' Cup Classic last October. This race, open to foreign-trained horses, had been won by foreign invaders the past three years, but there were no outsiders in the field this year. As the field came into the homestretch, Taiki Blizzard hit the front without any effort by his rider and held off the late charge of Osumi Max (Jpn) by one length. The winning time of 1:20.5 set a new track record for 1,400m at Tokyo. Winning jockey Yukio Okabe said, "I am satisfied with his performance today since it was his first start since October. The next start is Gl Yasuda Kinen at Tokyo on June 8. This horse has been narrowly beaten in Group 1 company three times and I really want him to capture a Group 1."
