TRIPLE THREAT: IT'S "SILVER" BY A SLIVER IN THE PREAKNESS You can't accuse **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) of being camera shy. Just a head in front at the wire in the Kentucky Derby two weeks ago, the gritty grey found himself involved in yet another photo finish at Pimlico yesterday afternoon. He grabbed the spotlight once again, getting a head in front of **Free House** (Smokester) in the final strides to take the second jewel in the Triple Crown, the GI \$500,000 Preakness S. "This was the tough one," said trainer Bob Baffert. "I'm still numb. I wasn't sure he had won. I can't even think about the Triple Crown; I have to treat it like just another race. (Owners Bob and Beverly Lewis) dream in Technicolor, but I dream in black and white." The race set up much as the Derby did, with **Free House** following pacesetter **Cryp Too** (Cryptoclearance) (ninth) to the far turn before taking command as those early fractions took their toll. Silver Charm came to him as they hit the top of the stretch, but this time **Free House**, who faded to third in the Derby, refused to fold. It looked like it would be those two to the wire and if that had been the case, racing might not be sitting on its first Triple Crown challenge since 1989. Winning his first Preakness ever, jockey Gary Stevens credited the late surge of Derby runner-up **Captain Bodgit** (Saint Ballado) with lighting the spark which fired his colt past **Free House** in the last jump. "My horse started to get tired," he said. "I didn't know whether I was going to get by **Free House** or not. But once **Captain Bodgit** came and (Silver Charm) saw him, he just put it in another gear." It has been 19 years since **Affirmed** outgamed **Alydar** to take the Triple Crown in 1978; it has been eight years since Sunday Silence carried two-thirds of the Triple to Belmont Park, only to be beaten in the final jewel by arch rival **Easy Goer**. With a \$5 million bonus on the line and the hopes of the sports world on Silver Charm's back, the 1997 Visa Triple Crown Challenge continues in the GI Belmont Stakes June 7.

As they had in the GI Santa Anita Derby April 5, Silver Charm and **Free House** hooked up for the final drive in yesterday's second leg of the Triple Crown and for a furlong it looked like an instant replay. Resolute along the rail, Santa Anita Derby victor **Free House** refused to give in, but when **Captain Bodgit** came flying on the outside, Kentucky Derby winner Silver Charm, sandwiched between the two, displayed the heart of a hero to win the Preakness by a head. "It's so thrilling," said owner Bob Lewis. "We have two legs accomplished --may the best horse win at Belmont, but I'm thinking positively of Silver Charm." As for the gutsy runner-up, jockey Kent Desormeaux said, "I asked him at about the three-sixteenths pole and he gave it. But in the last 70 yards, Silver Charm came again. It kind of caught my horse off guard. I needed one more surge at the end, but I couldn't find it." Running against the bias, Derby runner-up **Captain Bodgit** just missed. "He didn't break real sharp," said his trainer, Gary Capuano. "He was way back going down the backside. But boy, what a late run. It looked like there was no way to catch up, but at the sixteenth pole, he was really coming. There is no question that he's a champ, but the other two horses are champs, too." **TOUCH GOLD** (Deputy Minister), runaway winner of the GI Lexington S. last out, stumbled badly leaving the gate, was steadied at the half-mile pole, then rallied to reach contention midstretch before being steadied again inside **Free House** near the eighth pole. He finished with good courage to be fourth, but grabbed his left front quarter badly at the break.
