PREAKNESS TRIO LOOK TOWARD BELMONT

The top three finishers in Saturday's GI Preakness S. started regrouping vesterday for the final battle in the Triple Crown, the June 7 Gl Belmont S. Kentucky Derby and Preakness champion Silver Charm (Silver Buck) shipped back to Churchill Downs early Sunday morning. The grey colt will have most of his pre-Belmont preparations in Kentucky, according to trainer Bob Baffert and will ship to Belmont Park a week or six days before attempting to become racing's 12th Triple Crown winner. "If my horse feels like I do, he's got no shot to win the Triple Crown," Baffert joked a day after Silver Charm narrowly edged out Free House (Smokester) and Captain Bodgit (Saint Ballado) in a dramatic photo finish. Silver Charm arrived at Churchill Downs at 9 a.m. Sunday and exercise rider Larry Damore, who traveled with the colt, observed, "He's bouncing, he's alive, he's iumping around. We'll see (how he's doing) in a couple of days. When he gets on the track you can really tell a lot, how he's on the muscle and what he's doing. Preakness runner-up Free House was scheduled to ship directly to Belmont Park this morning. Trainer Paco Gonzalez said he was happy with his colt's performance in the Preakness. "I was so happy because he ran a big race. It's hard to lose a race like that, especially a classic. But I'm happy he proved he's a nice horse." Captain Bodgit, third Saturday, will train up to the Belmont at Bowie, trainer Gary Capuano's home base. Capuano explained, "If we go, it would be the day before. That's what we did for the Wood and we won. Why should we change anything? We'll just keep him relaxed and quiet here." Another Preakness alum who may join the top three in the Belmont, is fourth-place finisher Touch Gold (Deputy Minister). The colt grabbed his left fore quarter when he stumbled badly at the start of the race, but trainer David Hofmans was encouraged Sunday morning when checking the colt out and planned to send him to New York Monday. "First of all, there is no heat in the foot this morning (Sunday), which is a very positive sign," Hofmans said. "The vet said last night that we might expect him to be sore this morning, but he's not. He goes to Belmont tomorrow on a van with Free House. I'm going home to California, but I'll be back next Saturday and depending on how his foot looks then, we'll decide whether to go ahead and go for the Belmont." The prospective Belmont field of six is rounded out by Crypto Star (Cryptoclearance) and GII Illinois Derby winner Wild Rush (Wild Again).

"There was no excuse for him today, he just didn't fire," his jockey Craig Perret said. "It's as simple as that. Maybe his past races have taken too much out of him."
