**QUEEN TO ATTEND QUEEN'S PLATE** Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and His Royal Highness The Duke of Edinburgh will be on hand at Woodbine Race-track June 29 to attend this year's 138th running of the Queen's Plate. This will mark the third time the royal couple have been in Toronto for the Canadian Classic, first visiting for the 100th edition in 1959, and then again in 1973. The Queen will present the traditional 50 guineas and the Queen's Plate trophy to the winning owner.

**RECORD HANDLE ON '97 PREAKNESS** The final figures for the total handle on the 1997 Preakness S. are in, with wagering both in Maryland and from sources around the country reaching all-time highs on the race. A total of \$23,924,000 was bet on the Preakness outside of Maryland, with \$2,677,000 wagered in state. In addition, a record \$8,526,000 was wagered throughout Preakness Day in Maryland, and a record \$8,927,000 was handled on the remainder of Pimlico's Preakness Day card around the country. Wagering from all sources on the Pimlico card on Preakness Day was \$41,377,000, up 16.4 percent from last year. Total attendance at the Maryland tracks on Preakness Day also showed gains, with 102,118 visiting Pimlico, Laurel, Rosecroft and Delmarva, up from 97,751 in 1996.

At odds of 20-1, Classic Park (GB) became the longest-priced winner of this Irish Classic since it was first run in 1923. She also gave her young trainer Aidan O'Brien, who also saddled the much more fancied runner-up Strawberry Roan (Ire), his first Classic success. As she did in the 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, OH NELLIE (Tilt The Stars) set the pace from the start and still led at the quarter-mile mark, but jockey Stephen Craine brought Classic Park through along the rail to split Oh Nellie and SEEBE (Danzig) entering the final furlong and go clear, running on strongly to the line. Strawberry Roan can be considered unlucky as she found traffic problems in trying to find a way through and had to be switched to the wide outside at the eighth pole, finishing strongly for the runner-up berth. Caiseal Ros (Ire) just pipped English challenger RYAFAN (Lear Fan), the 3-1 favourite, on the line for third. O'Brien said: "I'm delighted my fillies ran so well. We have not worked them together as we were concentrating on having each of them fresh and at their best for this. Classic Park quickened really well and won on merit, but I think Strawberry Roan was very unlucky as she was hit with a whip at least once when trying to come between horses and had to be switched to the outside." Classic Park will be aimed at the G1 Coronation S. over a mile at Royal Ascot June 18, while Strawberry Roan is likely for the G1 Epsom Oaks June 6.

Hidden Lake, first in the Dec. 29 Gil La Brea S., was winless in her four prior starts this year but had been third in the GI Santa Margarita H. in March and second in the May 3 Gill Humana Distaff H. at Churchill in her latest outing. The bay rated off the pace set by **GOLDEN GALE** (Summer Squall), then split rivals in the stretch to get to the lead and draw away to an impressive score. "Around the turn I had a ton of horse, but I didn't want to commit to the inside or the outside today," winning jockey Richard Migliore said. "When the hole opened for her, I knew she'd be home free." Winning trainer John Kimmel, who also saddled runner-up Flat Fleet Feet, indicated that the winner may run next in the June 28 Hempstead H. at Belmont. The second-place finisher broke slowly and rallied to grab the place spot. "She ran real good considering how bad she broke out of the gate," said her rider, Mike Smith. "I had to come from off the pace with her today because I had no choice. Overall, she recovered and finished well." **CAPOTE BELLE** (Capote), the 7-2 third choice, forced the pace between rivals and then took the lead with two furlongs to go but weakened in the stretch to finish fifth. **MY FLAG** (Easy Goer), the 2-1 favorite, raced from the back of the pack early but lacked a response in the stretch. "I don't know what went wrong," said her trainer, Shug McGaughey. "She had trained super, she looked great, and I thought she warmed up great, too. After the race, I talked to (jockey Jerry Bailey) and he couldn't figure out what happened, either."
