CLASSIC DOUBLE FOR IRISHMAN

AIDAN O'BRIEN Just 24 hours after saddling his first Classic winner, sending out Classic Park (GB) to take the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, young Irish trainer Aidan O'Brien completed a famous "double" when his Desert King (Ire) (Danehill) ran away with yesterday's G1 Lexus Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh. The victory also gave owner Michael Tabor his second European Classic victory this season, following Entrepreneur (GB) in the G1 English 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, and gave his sire Danehill (Danzig), champion sire in Australia for the past three seasons, his first Classic victory in the Northern Hemisphere. The 3-1 second favorite, Desert King made his move at the guarter pole to come to the fore on the outside and in a matter of a few strides the race was over, with O'Brien's colt going clear and only Verglas (Ire) (Highest Honor {Fr}) coming out of the pack to throw down any sort of challenge. "I was always confident before the race," said the 26-year-old O'Brien. "I never thought the distance would be any problem. He has always been a very good horse." O'Brien and Tabor now have to decide whether or not to run the colt in the Vodafone Epsom Derby on June 7, for which Entrepreneur, trained by Michael Stoute, is even-money favourite at present.

An impressive 5 1/2-length winner of the G3 Tetrarch S. on his previous start May 3, Desert King (Ire) capped off an impressive weekend for trainer Aidan O'Brien, rallying to post a decisive victory in this Irish Classic. The colt settled off the fast pace set by stable companion SHAREMONO (Woodman), who was several lengths clear of the field on the turn, but as his entrymate faded to last Desert King came running on the outside to take command and draw clear. While a triumph for Desert King and his conditioner, the race looks almost certain to rule out the Epsom Derby June 7 for Robert Sangster's disappointing favourite, REVOQUE (IRE) (Fairy King), who had every chance but simply died at the quarter pole. His trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam was at a loss to explain the dismal showing, saying: "He went there three furlongs out and it looked only a matter of how far he would win, but he simply died a death. He emptied. We have been in harder fights before, but we are really up against it now and the Derby looks very unlikely for Revoque."

Single Empire (Ire) and Panama City provided their trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam with some consolation for Revogue (Ire)'s dismal showing at The Curragh by finishing first and third, but there should have been a German victory. Jockey Terence Hellier, aboard Ungaro (Ger), somehow conjured defeat out of victory. His colt quickened well early in the straight and went clear, looking the certain winner, but Hellier failed to notice the strong run of Single Empire on the very wide outside and allowed his mount to be caught on the line and beaten a nose. The race also produced a problem for jockey Kieren Fallon, who has been banned for 10 days (June 6-17) and will therefore miss the Epsom Derby meeting (June 6-8) and the first day of the Royal Ascot meet (June 17) after his mount MUSICAL DANCER (Dixieland Band) was disqualified from fifth place and demoted to seventh. Fallon allowed his mount to veer sharply in the closing stages, hampering RISIAT (IRE) (Waajib {Ire}). The rider was in fact banned for six days by the Italian stewards, but he had already collected a four-day suspension Saturday at Doncaster in England, so the two suspensions have been added together. He will therefore miss a 'plum' ride for Cecil on either Reams Of Verse or Yashmak in the Epsom Oaks on June 6. He is considering an appeal against yesterday's suspension.

A dramatic final strides victory for Sasuru (GB), who now has the King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot at the end of July as his main target. The colt raced in third while the Godolphin challenger TAMAYAZ (Gone West) set a good pace, but the frontrunner quickly back-pedalled after the turn. Wixim took over, only to soon be challenged by Sasuru on his outside. Wixim came away from the rail and took Sasuru towards the centre of the track and these two battled it out to the line, with the latter just prevailing. Winning trainer Geoffrey Wragg said: "He's improving all the time and I am sure he will definitely be better over a mile and a half so the King George has to be his long-term target, but he may run at Royal Ascot in either the (G2) Prince Of Wales S. (June 17) or the (G2) Hardwicke S. (June 20)." Michael Hills, who rode Sasuru, said: "He's a real classy horse, improving with every race. He misbehaved on the way to the start, continually messing around, but he's very serious in a race. Wixim took him wide, but I always knew he would win."
