URGENT REQUEST TO FLAG IS UP FARM Urgent Request (Ire) (Rainbow Quest), winner of the 1995 GI Santa Anita H., will stand the 1998 breeding season at Flag Is Up Farms in Solvang, California. The seven-year-old started his career in England where he won the G3 Rose Of Lancaster S. He was second in the 1994 Hong Kong International Vase before shipping to the U.S. later that year. The Irish-bred grey won three of his 12 starts in America, adding the 1996 GII San Marcos H. at a mile and a guarter on the dirt and the 1996 GIII Oak Tree Breeders' Cup Mile, in which he set a course record on the Santa Anita grass, to his Big 'Cap score. He retired with earnings of over \$1.2 million. Urgent Request will stand for a fee of \$4,000, live foal, with a two-forone package available for approved mares in 1998.

**DESERT KING TO MISS DERBIES** Last weekend's Lexus Irish 2000 Guineas hero Desert King (Ire) (Danehill) will not be trained for either the Vodafone Epsom Derby on June 7 or the Budweiser Irish Derby on June 29. Owner Michael Tabor and trainer Aidan O'Brien have decided to aim their new Classic winner instead at the G1 St. James' Palace S. over a mile at Royal Ascot on June 17. Desert King has raced three times this year, adding the G3 Omni Racing Tetrarch S. at the Curragh to his Guineas win and finishing second in the G3 Gladness S. over the same course in his 1997 debut. To date, the bay three-year-old has raced eight times for four wins and three seconds and earnings of \$298,768.

Iktamal (Danzig Connection), winner of the G1 Haydock Park Sprint Cup last year, has been retired from racing, according to a story in yesterday's Racing Post. The five-year-old, highweight older horse at five to seven furlongs last year in England, was troubled by a recurrent leg injury originally suffered while preparing for the Hong Kong International races last December. Although acquired by Godolphin last winter, the horse had never started for his new owners. The Racing Post reports Iktamal is now on the market as a stallion prospect. The chestnut stallion retires with seven wins in 21 starts for earnings of \$240,968.

Trainer Henry Cecil told the Post, "Prince Khalid would very much like to win the English Oaks. Therefore he feels both fillies should take their chance if the ground is right."


