“SKIP” ECLIPSES “GOLD” IN MASSCAP

He earned his Eclipse Award with wins in the Gil Toyota Blue Grass, Gil Ohio Derby, Gil Haskell Invitational, Gil Woodbine Million, and then in his “piece de resistance,” an electrifying photo-finish victory over two-time Horse of the Year Cigar in the Gil Jockey Club Gold Cup October 5. But last year’s champion three-year-old **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) had trouble finding his way to the winner’s circle at the start of his four-year-old campaign, dropping four straight races before regaining his championship form with a game performance in yesterday’s Gil Massachusetts H. at Suffolk Downs. The gunmetal grey dueled 79-1 **Topsy Robsy** (Topsider) through three-quarters in 1:10 4/5; as the longshot faded, **Formal Gold** (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) picked up the gauntlet and the two battled their way down the Suffolk stretch, with Skip Away putting a head in front just strides from the finish. “He’s such a great horse,” said trainer Sonny Hine. “You end up falling in love with him--you gotta love him. He just tries hard all the time.” Added jockey Shane Sellers, “I didn’t want to win this race for Shane Sellers. I wanted to win this race for Skip Away. There was so much pressure on this horse because he beat Cigar last year and he was supposed to come out this year and be Horse of the Year. But sometimes people forget that this is horse racing.”

WILD RUSH IN RAPID BELMONT BREEZE Gil Illinois Derby winner **Wild Rush** (Wild Again), prepping for the Gil Belmont S. June 7, zipped six furlongs in 1:10 4/5 over Hollywood Park’s main track yesterday morning. “He worked awesome,” said trainer Richard Mandella. “All week long I’ve been reading that each of the (Belmont) horses has been working great. It sounds like a broken record, but my horse really looked fantastic this morning.” The colt heads to New York Monday night for his attempt to derail Silver Charm’s Triple Crown train. “Everyone seems to be pulling for Silver Charm, but I won’t have any trouble sleeping at night if we beat him,” Mandella said with a smile. “I have all the respect in the world for Silver Charm and his connections, but I’m really excited about my colt’s chances. I’ve never run a horse in the Belmont before...but I’ve got the right horse and now’s the right time.”

Sent off the odds-on choice in his first three starts of the year after capping an award-winning three-year-old season with a victory over Cigar, Skip Away had run well enough to finish second in the Gil Donn H. and Gil Gulfstream Park H. but lost some of his backers when finishing a disappointing third in the Texas Mile April 20. Let go at 3-1 in the Gil Pimlico Special, the colt bounced back to be a solid second once again and the handicappers regained their confidence, sending him off the 3-5 favorite here. But the champ had to work for his victory, outgaming Donn H. winner Formal Gold for his first score of the season. “He put himself into the game today,” said jockey Shane Sellers. “I was confident going into the first turn because I knew I’d gotten to the front without having to rush this horse off his feet. (In the stretch) Jerry (Bailey, aboard Formal Gold) was crowding me, but that’s his job. He’s a great rider and that’s what he’s supposed to do. But after the race he pulled up with me and he said congratulations.” The runner-up was making his first start since running fifth in the Dubai World Cup April 3.

Unsuccessful against colts in the GI Santa Anita Derby and then demoted from third to eighth by the stewards in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 2 after making a left turn during the stretch drive, Sharp Cat got back on track backing up to a mile off that nine-furlong affair. Already a two-time Grade I winner on the year and two-for-two at a mile, the filly was bet down to even money and led every step for a decisive score. "She broke alertly and got comfortable underneath me--she was really just cruising on the backside," said jockey Gary Stevens. "She was setting a blazing pace, but she was well within herself. She was really full of run. When we galloped out, I chirped to her just to see how she'd respond, and she broke running again." Added trainer D. Wayne Lukas, "When she gets her own way like that, she gets stronger and stronger. She's got a lot of talent." The filly will now point for the second leg of Belmont's "Triple Tiara," the Mother Goose S. June 21.

LOOK DAGGERS PUT DOWN After a two-and-a-half month battle, **Look Daggers** (Diesis {GB}) had to be euthanized Friday. The filly suffered a fractured pelvis in the GI Orchid H. at Gulfstream Park March 16. She remained at Gulfstream until the backside was closed, moving to Pin Oak Farm in Versailles, Kentucky at the beginning of May. She seemed to improve at first, but the four-year-old took a turn for the worse last week. Her owner, Josephine Abercrombie, said, "She had seemed to respond in the first few weeks she was here, but the middle of last week she was acting funny and the doctor said he wanted to X-ray her. Afterwards he said the (right) pelvis was shattered and there was no chance it would ever heal. He said she would be stall-bound for the rest of her life."

This year's French Derby is a very close one to call. **Shaka (GB)** (Exit To Nowhere) is the probable favorite on the strength of his win in the May 3 G2 Prix Hocquart over the distance, with **Oscar (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) a length second--but the connections of Oscar are confident of revenge on Shaka. **Peintre Celebre** (Nureyev), who impressed when beating **Astarabad** (Alleged) by two lengths in G2 Prix Greffulhe April 20, could give owner Daniel Wildenstein and trainer Andre Fabre their first victories in this event. **Fragrant Mix (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}) has won all three starts this year, including the G2 Prix Noailles, with Shaka a well-beaten third. **Voyagers Quest** (Dynaformer) won the G3 Thresher Classic Trial at Sandown April 26, beating two much-fancied Epsom Derby (June 7) contenders, Benny The Dip and Silver Patriarch, subsequent winners respectively of the G2 Dante S. and G3 Lingfield Derby Trial.
