FRENCH DERBY: A CAUSE "CELEBRE" Peintre Celebre (Nureyev), making only his second start of the season, produced a superb effort to catch the Aga Khan's **Astarabad** (Alleged) deep in the stretch and pull away to give owner/breeder Daniel Wildenstein, trainer Andre Fabre and jockey Olivier Peslier their first-ever French Derby wins at Chantilly yesterday. Hero of the G2 Prix Greffulhe last time out, Peintre Celebre was caught behind horses nearing the final furlong but found running room late and ran out a very easy winner, holding **Oscar (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) at bay for a two-length victory, with **Astarabad** holding on for third. Andre Fabre was delighted with his first French Derby victory, saying: "This colt is a really nice horse. He is beautifully-bred, with a fantastic sire and a great pedigree. I always knew he had classic potential after he won on his debut at Deauville last August. From then on we always had one of the Derbies in mind for him and that was why he was so lightly raced. This was only his fourth start today. I am very happy for Mr. Wildenstein, in fact happier for him than for myself. I will discuss future plans for the horse with him. We might look at some big races in England, but the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe is the major target." Triumphant jockey Olivier Peslier said: "This has broken the ice for everyone. Peintre Celebre started well, but then I waited with him along the inside. I had trouble finding a gap when I wanted it in the straight, as I was blocked behind the two English horses; I had to wait and wait. But once we found the opening, he accelerated brilliantly and I knew that I would be able to catch **Astarabad** in front. It would have taken a super horse to beat us today."

Sidney Craig's new purchase **VOYAGERS QUEST** (Dynaformer) set the pace and still led at the quarter-mile mark, but he faded very quickly in the straight and **Astarabad** shot through to grab the lead and go clear, the race apparently at his mercy. Peintre Celebre was having trouble finding an opening, but jockey Olivier Peslier found his gap inside the eighth pole and his mount quickened brilliantly to take the lead and draw off for an impressive victory. **Oscar (Ire)** finished strongly for second, having come from a long way back. Making only his fourth start here, Peintre Celebre had won over a mile on his debut at Deauville in mid-August and was then third to **Nombre Premier** in the G3 Prix des Chenes in early September. On his only previous start this year he beat **Astarabad** by two lengths in the Prix Greffulhe over a mile and five-sixteenths April 20. While future plans for the winner have not yet been mapped out, trainer Pascal Bary hopes to run fast-finishing **Oscar** in the Budweiser Irish Derby at the end of June. "My colt ran a super race," he said. "He's only run four times and is still inexperienced and can only improve." Alain de Royer-Dupre, trainer of **Astarabad**, said: "Gerald Mosse rode a great race on **Astarabad** and looked like he had stolen it when he went clear. But perhaps the horse lacks that little bit of class." **Voyagers Quest** was a great disappointment. Rider John Reid was nonplussed, saying: "I don't know why he faded so badly. He quit completely at the quarter-mile mark."

A multiple Group stakes winner in Europe, Donna Viola (GB) began her assault on American racing last November, taking the GI Yellow Ribbon S. at Hollywood. Third in the GII Santa Ana H. after a four-and-a-half month absence following that race, the talented mare came back to capture the GII Santa Barbara H. last out April 19 and she made it three-for-four in the States with this score. Off at 8-5, the bay settled in fifth through six furlongs in 1:11 2/5, then moved up on the rail to join the leaders at the top of the stretch, switching to the outside for the drive and running all out down the lane to win a three-way photo. "She took a funny step with me around the first turn," said winning jockey Gary Stevens. "She hit a soft spot, and she didn't get comfortable after that. I had to start riding her early... considering all that, she really overpowered them because she didn't run her best race." The victory was the first in a Grade I for trainer Ben Cecil, who took over Donna Viola's training after the Yellow Ribbon. He will go for another with the mare in the GI Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood June 29.

Showing that his good fourth to Entrepreneur (GB) in the English 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 3 was no fluke and advertising the form of that Classic only days before the winner runs in Saturday's Epsom Derby (June 7), Starborough (GB) led throughout, going clear at the finish. His trainer David Loder said: "Most people seemed surprised at how well he ran in the 2000 Guineas, but I wasn't. Lester Piggott rode him in his work before the race and said he would finish in the first four. And now he has followed up with this victory. It is difficult to weigh up the quality of the form today, but I would think he has done enough to justify running him in the St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot (June 17)." At Ascot, Starborough will meet last weekend's Irish 2000 Guineas winner Desert King (Ire). Richard Hills, rider of runner-up Mamalik, collected a four-day suspension after the stewards found him guilty of careless riding early in the race when his mount badly hampered CIRINO (Gone West).
