### TOUCH GOLD WINS BELMONT Silver

Charm (Silver Buck)'s bid to become the 12th winner of the Triple Crown was spoiled Saturday as **Touch Gold** (Deputy Minister), an unlucky fourth in the Preakness, drove past the Derby and Preakness winner to take the 129th running of the Belmont S. by three-quarters of a length. The crowd of 70,682, third largest in Belmont S. history, rose to its feet as Silver Charm put a head in front at the top of the stretch. The Preakness runner-up **Free House** (Smokester) joined him on the outside and the two battled down the Belmont stretch. Just as Silver Charm appeared to have bested his rival, Touch Gold came flying down the center of the track to steal the carnations in the final strides. Silver Charm becomes the 13th horse to suffer defeat in the Belmont after taking the first two legs of the Triple Crown. Jockey Chris McCarron, aboard Touch Gold, now knows what it's like to be both spoiler and spoiled. "The feeling of losing the Triple Crown is crushing," said McCarron, who lost the Belmont after winning the Derby and Preakness with Alysheba in 1987. "I was never more confident than with Alysheba. I thought he was a mortal lock in the Belmont. I didn't think there was any way he could get beat, but he did." How did it feel to take the Crown away from Silver Charm? "Gallop back I was looking at the crowd and I saw a whole lot of unhappy faces," McCarron said. "It started to sink in, but I'm certainly grateful to be on the horse that upset the apple cart. I'm happy for Touch Gold. He ran such a tough race in the Preakness--if he hadn't fallen on his face leaving the gate, Silver Charm might not have been going for the Triple Crown." Jockey Gary Stevens, rider of Silver Charm, had nothing but praise for his horse. "He ran the best of all his three Triple Crown races, and he made the most explosive move of the three races," he said. "I knew I had Free House any time I wanted him, and there was a feeling I had, a lump in my stomach that 'We're going to win the Triple Crown.' But then, out of the corner of my eye, I caught a shadow..."

Touch Gold, fourth in the Preakness after a nightmare trip, enjoyed an untroubled if eventful journey in the Belmont and came through with a last-surge victory. The colt, a runaway victor of the Gil Lexington S. April 20, skipped the Derby, but was more than ready for the mile and a half of the Belmont. He broke a step slowly again, but then sprinted to the lead on the first turn and led through a moderate half in :49 1/5; the pace quickened on the backstretch and he dropped back to fourth as stablemate WILD RUSH (Wild Again) took over the lead with Silver Charm just off his flank. It looked for a moment as if the hero of the Derby and Preakness would add the Belmont to his Crown, but after putting away a game Free House midstretch, the even-money favorite had to face the challenge of Touch Gold, and he came up less than a length short. "(Touch Gold) proved he was a better horse today," said winning trainer David Hofmans. "You'll hear a lot more about him down the road." Silver Charm's trainer Bob Baffert, said, "Silver Charm ran his heart out. We came up just a little bit short." While Baffert has not yet thought of the future for his colt, Hofmans mentioned the Haskell Invitational Aug. 3 at Monmouth and then the Travers at Saratoga Aug. 23 as possible goals for Touch Gold.

Benny the Dip provided trainer John Gosden and jockey Willie Ryan with a dramatic first Derby victory. Ryan was only booked for the mount a few days ago when Olivier Peslier, who had been on board Benny The Dip when he won the G2 Dante S. at York May 14, opted to partner **CLOUDINGS (IRE)** (Sadler's Wells) (7th). **CRYSTAL HEARTED (GB)** (Broken Hearted {Ire}) led from the gate, while 2000 Guineas winner and 4-6 favorite **ENTREPRENEUR (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) was well back on the outside of the field. After a half-mile Benny The Dip had moved closer to the leader and at the half-mile pole, he took command of the race, going quickly clear of the field. Only Silver Patriarch (Ire) came out of the pack to chase the leader and closed dramatically inside the final furlong to just miss catching Benny The Dip at the wire. The winner's owner and breeder Landon Knight, bed-ridden at home in Ohio, listened to the race over the telephone. Gosden was quick to pay tribute to Knight: "This is a tremendous win for Mr Knight. He has always sent me one horse a year to train and they have always been out of his mare Rascal Rascal, who is now dead." Gosden indicated Benny the Dip will run next in the Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh June 29. Jubilant jockey Willie Ryan, said: "I sat on the horse for the first time only on Thursday and he wasn't all that impressive then, but he was today! The plan was to be positive and ride him like he stays a mile and a half, which is what I did. The early pace wasn't that fast, which helped us. My horse stuck on really gamely at the end when Silver Patriarch came to him. I didn't know if I had won in the photo, I was only hopeful." As for Entrepreneur's fourth-place finish, his rider Michael Kinane said: "It was a very disappointing performance. He didn't have an easy passage and got bumped twice, but he was never really going and was never happy on the track and didn't come down the hill at all well."

Ops Smile won the May 17 GII Dixie H. at Pimlico by a nose in his previous start. The winner trailed the field of eight early before rallying hard in the middle of the track to get up for the victory in the final seventy yards. "He was really relaxed today," winning jockey Robbie Davis said. "I didn't want to leave him with too much to do, but he is a stretch-running horse, and I was just hoping that there would be a fast pace. He came around them and ran them down today." Winning trainer J. William Boniface indicated that the winner may start next in the Caesar's International H. at Atlantic City June 28. Flag Down also rallied in the stretch but could not out finish the winner. Favored Always a Classic forced the early pace before taking the lead around the far but tired to third. Second-choice LABEEB (GB) (Lear Fan) ducked out sharply at the quarter-pole and unseated jockey John Velazquez.

A first graded stake win for 14-1 shot Polar Prince (Ire), who won a stake in Rome on his previous start May 25. Winner now of 6 of his eighteen lifetime starts, this was his first win beyond seven furlongs. Always well-placed, Polar Prince hugged the inside rail and came through to challenge Cap Juluca (Ire) at the quarter pole and ran on well up the Epsom hill, having enough left to withstand the strong late finish of the 9-4 favorite Faithful Son. Winning trainer Michael Jarvis said: "He was just shortening up in the last 50 yards and this is as far as he wants to go. The main aim for him is the (G1) Prix Jacques Le Marois at Deauville (August 17), but he may have another race before then."
