BELMONT STAKES WRAP-UP Belmont S. winner Touch Gold (Deputy Minister) came back from his three-quarter length victory in good order, according to trainer David Hofmans. The colt, fourth after stumbling badly at the start of the Preakness and suffering a grabbed left front quarter, raced with a patch on the injured hoof Saturday. "The hoof is doing real well," said Hofmans yesterday. "We took the patch off last night after the Belmont and we had to take some of the (hoof) wall off. That had me a little concerned last night, but this morning the foot is cold. I think we'll keep the patch off as long as he lets me not train him, which I'm hoping is about a week. But he's real tough and I'm not sure that is going to happen." As for future plans, the trainer said, "The Travers (August 23) is definitely in the picture, especially if Silver Charm (Silver Buck) and Free House (Smokester) go in there, too. I think it would be terrific to get those three horses together and get this whole thing rolling again. I can't wait for these three to meet again. Won't that be something?" And the outcome of a rematch? "With no trouble in the race, I think Touch Gold will beat Silver Charm every time," he said. "I think he's a little better horse. I think Touch Gold is ready to peak, that he's still coming up to his best. You won't see the best from this horse until the Breeders' Cup. As they say, you ain't seen nothing yet." Countered trainer Bob Baffert, whose Silver Charm took twothirds of the Triple Crown before finishing a gallant second in the Belmont S., "He has a right to brag about his horse. I think these horses will take turns beating one another. It's whoever has the luck." As for his next target, Baffert is considering his options, which include the July 13 Gli Swaps S. at Hollywood Park. The Swaps currently offers a purse of \$500,000, but Hollywood management has already said that they will raise it if they can get Touch Gold, Silver Charm and Free House, all based in California, back in the starting gate together. "I talked to the three trainers two weeks ago," Hollywood Park racing secretary Martin Panza said. "We're going to present the Thoroughbred Owners of California (which must approve changes in purses) with some options for the Swaps and we want to talk to the three trainers and see what's best for them. We're considering raising the purse." Touch Gold and Silver Charm shared a flight out of New York yesterday morning, with Silver Charm getting dropped off at Churchill Downs and Touch Gold continuing on to California.

Mousse Glacee had difficulty finding a way through the field and had to quicken later than trainer Jean Lesbordes would have liked. "She did not have the best trip" he said. "She had no room to go but when she found a way she finished very strongly. She will definitely run in the Irish Oaks." Trainer Pascal Bary, who saddled favored Brilliance (Fr) to finish third, said: "If she has recovered from this, she will run in the Irish Oaks July 13 at the Curragh."

#### BELMONT HANDLE A NEW YORK RECORD

Belmont Park's total handle of \$46,719,629 on Saturday's Belmont S. card was an all-time record for New York, surpassing the old mark of \$40,909,598 set on Breeders' Cup Day, 1995. The largest previous Belmont S. Day handle was \$38,712,984, set last year. On-track handle at Belmont was \$9,215,728, the fourth-largest in track history and second largest for the Belmont S. "We're extremely grateful for the tremendous support shown by racing fans," said New York Racing Association President and Chief Operating Officer Terry Meyocks, "The excitement generated by Silver Charm's attempt for the Triple Crown, the building rivalry among the horses competing and outstanding coverage by the media led to one of the most exciting days in the history of Belmont Park. Visa has done a great job in helping promote Triple Crown events as well as Thoroughbred racing and we are very grateful to them. In addition, we would like to thank the connections of all of the Belmont S. horses for their great cooperation to build this day."

Copelan's Vanity, a Copelan filly from the Mark Casse consignment, turned in the fastest breeze during vesterday's Under Tack Show for the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Annual June Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training and Horses of Racing Age. Working over the track at the OBS sales grounds, the filly, listed as Hip #59, went a half-mile in :47; she is the first foal out of the stakesplaced Hy Vanity (Proud Appeal). Another filly by Copelan named Copelan's Angel, Hip #4, and a colt by Rubiano named Credulous, Hip #239, recorded the quickest three-furlong times, both going in :34 4/5. With an average of 10.3 horses per race, Lone Star Park leads the list of tracks currently racing in average field size, according to statistics from The Jockey Club Information Systems. Next on the list was Churchill Downs with 9.2 horses per race; Belmont Park with 9; and Hollywood Park with 8.6. "One of the keys to our success has been the support of the horsemen," said Lone Star Vice President and General Manager Corey Johnson. Through its first 33 days of operation, Lone Star, which opened for its inaugural meet April 17, has also averaged daily on-track attendance of 10,879 and total handle of \$2,493,137 daily on its live racing card.

Lone Star Park and the Texas Thoroughbred Association have added two Texas-bred stakes to the track's schedule. The \$50,000 Ranger for 3yo/up at six furlongs and \$50,000 Mockingbird for fillies and mares, 3yo/up, at the same distance, will be run July 13.

Then, about five months ago, I was on my pony and this horse jumped up and scarred my back with his front hoof--the next day we castrated him." Irish Wings will head to the GII American H. at Hollywood July 4.
