BONUS INCENTIVE FOR SWAPS? Hollywood Park, in an effort to attract Triple Crown rivals **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck), **Touch Gold** (Deputy Minister) and **Free House** (Smokester) to the July 13 GII Swaps S., has asked the Thoroughbred Owners of California to allow a proposed plan that would pay any Grade I winner \$700,000 for winning the race. Hollywood Racing Secretary Martin Panza expects to hear back from the TOC soon and is confident he can bring the three Triple Crown heroes to his track. "We've talked to all three trainers," Panza said. "Paco Gonzalez (the trainer of Free House) is very interested; he's not going to Monmouth. David Hofmans (the trainer of Touch Gold) is pretty much committed the same way. He'll run here. Bob Baffert (the trainer of Silver Charm) is going to Kentucky in a week and a half to see how his horse is doing. He's not committing one way or the other." Under Panza's plan, a Grade I winner would get \$700,000 for winning the race, which has a base purse of \$500,000. The bonus would only apply to the winner. Panza added that Hollywood would consider pushing the race back a week or two. Meanwhile, Monmouth Park management is not going to go down without a fight. The New Jersey track's Swaps-comparable GI Buick Haskell Invitational is already a \$1 million race and the August 3 date might be more desirable. Three Monmouth executives will be on the Hollywood backstretch Friday morning trying to convince Hofmans, Baffert and Gonzalez to run in their race. "Obviously, Hollywood Park has the horses in their own backyard, which makes them a more substantial threat than a track in the middle of nowhere," said Hal Handel, who heads the racing operation for the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority. "The thing we have going for us is the timing. I'd think those trainers would want to give their horses more time off."

CHURCHILL RAISES PURSES AGAIN Overnight purses at Churchill have been raised for the third time this meet. With the latest increase at 6½ percent, purses at the track have now risen nearly 30 percent since the meeting opened. The latest boost is a result of increased on-track and separate pool wagering as well as whole-card and out-of-state simulcasting. "The increase shows our racing product has held up very well," said vice president and racing secretary Jerry Botts. The latest purse increase does not affect stakes purses.

Celtic Warrior (Fast Play), 10th in this year's Kentucky Derby, was injured while finishing third in an allowance race at Churchill Sunday and has been retired. The three-year-old gelding suffered a condylar fracture of the left front cannon bone and also a fractured sesamoid in the leg; he underwent surgery at Lexington's Rood & Riddle equine hospital Sunday. A winner of two races and \$137,357, Celtic Warrior is recovering at trainer and co-owner Danny Hutt's barn at Churchill. "He'll stay here for about 60 days," said Hutt. "Then we'll turn him out at a friend's farm and I'll go pet him there for the rest of his life."
