“RACING TO THE BREEDERS’ CUP”

EXPANDED FOR ‘97 With the addition of two races, the 1997 “Racing to the Breeders’ Cup” series on ESPN will now offer 10 broadcasts, two more than in 1996. Joining the schedule are the GI Hollywood Gold Cup June 29 and the GI Travers S. from Saratoga Aug. 23. A total of 17 races, 12 of them Grade I, will be featured on the 10 telecasts. The series kicks off its sixth year with the \$1,000,000 Hollywood Gold Cup, to be run under the same conditions as this year’s \$4 million Breeders’ Cup Classic, and culminates with the GI Three Chimneys Spinster S. from Keeneland October 12.

STORM SONG ON THE SHELF Last year’s champion two-year-old filly **Storm Song** (Summer Squall) has been taken out of training and is being treated for ulcers, according to Dogwood Stable President Cot Campbell. “She has not been herself this year--winless in five races--and (trainer) Nick Zito and I decided to send her to Kentucky for a thorough physical,” said Campbell. “Dr. Larry Bramlage and Dr. Robert Copelan reported that she suffers from ulcers; she will be treated and turned out at Dr. Copelan’s barn, at least until mid-July. We hope her condition then will permit her to re-enter training in late summer and to compete at her proper level.”

SILVER CHARM HASKELL BOUND In the race with Hollywood Park to lure Triple Crown heroes **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck), **Touch Gold** (Deputy Minister) and **Free House** (Smokester), Monmouth Park picked up a big boost yesterday when Silver Charm’s trainer Bob Baffert indicated he is bound for the New Jersey track’s GI Buick Haskell Invitational. The other option for the top three-year-olds is the July 13 GI Swaps at Hollywood Park. “I couldn’t do both races and I’d like to go in the Haskell and then go in the Travers, which is three weeks away,” Baffert said. “That’s going to blow my whole Del Mar vacation, which will kill me. I’ve been known to change my mind, but right now it’s the Haskell.” Baffert said the key reason he would pick the Aug. 3 Monmouth race over the Swaps is the timing. However, Hollywood Park could move the date of the Swaps to accommodate Baffert and trainers David Hofmans and Paco Gonzalez. Any changes, however, have to be approved by the Thoroughbred Owners of California.

HANDLE UP AT SUFFOLK DOWNS Boosted by the success of simulcasting both at the track and at its simulcasting outlets, the handle for the 1996-97 season at Suffolk Downs, which ended Saturday, showed an increase for the fourth straight year. The East Boston, Massachusetts oval handled a total of \$129,210,989 for the 145 racing days from September 20, 1996 to June 7, 1997, compared to the \$116,383,213 handled for the 1995-96 meeting, a gain of 11 percent. While the daily average was down, from \$285,386 to \$271,024, the on-track handle rose from \$514,972 to \$527,391. Average daily attendance was also up slightly, from 4,083 to 4,096. "As the fans become more and more comfortable with simulcasting, it seems that they're more likely to bet some of their money that way, both here and at facilities which are taking our races," said Suffolk Downs Vice President of Racing Lou Raffetto, Jr. "The numbers bear out what we've said for a while. We're holding our own but we need to do better."

The New York Racing Association stewards are now allowing jockeys to ride in stakes races during suspensions, adopting a rule that has been in place for years in California. If a suspended jockey chooses to ride in a stakes race, he or she must add an additional day on to their suspensions. "This way, the trainer will get the rider he wants and the public will get the better rider," explained state steward John Joyce. "Naturally, the owner will be satisfied, too because the rider desired will be aboard. It doesn't take away any of the deterrent, either, because there's a day added on to the suspension."

Sam F Morrell, an owner who races both at NYRA tracks and at Finger Lakes, and Marc Siegelau, one of the industry's best-known advocates for the racing fan, have agreed to join the Board of Advisors of the Center to Preserve Racing, Inc. (CPR). The addition of Morrell and Siegelau brings the CPR Board to an even dozen, with several other members expected to be announced before the beginning of the Saratoga meet.

The stewards disqualified Old Chapel, still looking for his first win since taking the GIII Generous S. at Hollywood in December, 1995, for bearing out under left-handed whipping and placed him second.
