SWAPS WORTH \$1 MILLION? The battle for the best three-year-olds escalated Saturday. Hollywood Park officials and the Thoroughbred Owners of California announced that if the first three finishers in this year's GI Belmont S., Touch Gold (Deputy Minister), Silver Charm (Silver Buck) and Free House (Smokester), start in the GII Swaps S. at Hollywood July 13, the race will receive a \$500,000 purse supplement. Already offering a purse of \$500,000, the bonus would make the mile-and-an-eighth event worth \$1,000,000--but trainer Bob Baffert has indicated he would rather give Derby and Preakness winner Silver Charm an extra three weeks' rest and await the GI \$1,000,000 Buick Haskell Invitational at Monmouth August 3, Undaunted, TOC President and General Counsel John Van de Kamp said, "We believe (the Swaps supplement) is in the best interest of racing. These are the finest horses to come out of the Triple Crown in 20 years. The added purse money will be compensated for by the increase in handle as a result of these three great horses continuing their rivalry." The proposal calls for \$300,000 of the additional purse money to be funded by the purse pool and \$200,000 to come from Hollywood Park. The winner of the race would receive the entire supplement as well as the \$300,000 winner's share of the purse, bringing the payday to \$800,000. "These are very talented, highly competitive horses with an incredible will to win," said Hollywood Park President R.D. Hubbard. "We'd be thrilled to give California fans an opportunity to see them meet in their own backyard.

Fifth in the Dubai World Cup April 3, Formal Gold proved he had rebounded from the trip to the Middle East with a game second-place finish behind champion Skip Away in the GIII MassCap last out May 31. Bet down to 4-5 off that performance, the Canadian-bred colt rewarded his backers, coming from fourth with a three-wide sweep on the final turn and striding away from the field down the lane. "We hadn't planned on the Brooklyn at first, but he came out of his last race in such great shape that I had to run him in here," said winning trainer William Perry. "I really don't know what's next for him...(the Hollywood Gold Cup June 29) is doubtful. I wouldn't say the Whitney (GI at Saratoga August 2) was out of the question. Our goal is the Breeders' Cup. I don't know where Formal Gold figures in the mix right now, but I do know he is going to have to improve to compete with those California horses. But we do have a lot of time to get ready."

Gl Kentucky Oaks winner Blushing K.D. (Blushing John), scheduled to breeze for the first time since finishing a disappointing fourth in the GII Black-Eyed Susan last out May 16, had the work postponed vesterday. The filly, diagnosed with unusually low potassium levels in her blood following the Black-Eyed Susan, will get a few more days of jogging and galloping before stretching it out over the Churchill strip. "Her potassium level is up, but we're going to wait a few days before we work her," said trainer Sam David Jr. "She'll probably breeze next Friday. She's back to where we want her to be, but we just want to give her a few more days. Now that we know the potassium is the problem, we can monitor it and keep it up where it needs to be." David blamed a negative reaction to Lasix at Pimlico with aggravating the filly's problem. "We use a lot of Lasix and we've never had that reaction," he said. "But maybe it's just because she runs and works so hard. Maybe she just tries harder than she should."
