FIRST ISLAND DEAD Mollers Racing's dual Group 1 winner First Island (Dominion {GB}) died Saturday night after suffering a severe colic attack at trainer Geoffrey Wragg's stables in Newmarket. The five-year-old won last season's G1 Sussex S, at Goodwood and this season's G1 Lockinge S. at Newbury May 16. An expected run at this week's Royal Ascot meeting was canceled after First Island sustained a fractured cannon bone while exercising at Newmarket 12 days ago. Wragg's wife Patricia said yesterday, "We are all devastated to lose such a favorite. He was a great racehorse and a great friend." Mollers Racing's racing manager John Ferguson said: "In all likelihood the colic attack was caused by the stress suffered after the surgery to repair his cannon bone fracture, when screws had to be inserted in his leg. This reaction to surgery is unusual but not rare. The vets did all they could to save him but were not successful. It is a great tragedy for all concerned."

LANGFUHR RETIRED Canadian champion sprinter Langfuhr (Danzig) has been retired from racing after suffering a suspensory injury, according to a report in the Daily Racing Form. "I went into his stall (Friday) before he trained, and he had a slight bit of filling in his near fore," the five-year-old's trainer Mike Keogh told the Form. "We did some ultrasound on him, and some X-rays. My vet, Dr. Dan Duncan, (owner) Gus (Schickedanz) and I met (Saturday) and we all thought the best thing to do for him was to send him out a winner." Langfuhr captured the GI Metropolitan Mile in what would be his final start. He also scored victories in the GI Carter H., GI Vosburgh and GII Forego. In 23 starts, Langfuhr won nine times, finished second seven times and third once for earnings of \$698,574.

INJURY ENDS SUNSHACK'S CAREER Sunshack (GB) (Rainbow Quest), highweight at two in France, has been retired due to an injury to his left front ankle. Sunshack won the 1993 G1 Criterium de Saint Cloud, 1995 G1 Prix Royal Oak in France and the 1995 G1 Coronation Cup in England. The dark bay made three starts in the U.S., all this year and all second-place finishes, including placings in the GI Hollywood Turf H. and GI San Juan Capistrano Invitational. The six-year-old won six of 18 starts with earnings of \$744,266. He was sold last week and will be sent to stud in Japan.
