CLAIBORNE PURCHASES INTEREST IN EPSOM **DERBY WINNER** Claiborne Farm has purchased a half interest in 1997 Epsom Derby winner Benny the Dip (Silver Hawk). Owned by Landon Knight and trained in Europe by John Gosden, Benny the Dip will continue to race for the remainder of his three-year-old season. He will then retire to Claiborne for the 1998 breeding season, following in the footsteps of Blenheim II and Nijinsky II, previous English Derby winners to stand at Claiborne. "The Hancock family has a long history with stallions who were classic winners in Europe--especially the Epsom Derby," said Claiborne spokesperson Dell Hancock. "And as a grandson of Roberto, Benny the Dip will offer an excellent breeding opportunity from the Roberto line. We hope that our success with Epsom Derby winners, like Nijinsky II and Sir Ivor, will continue." To date, Benny the Dip has raced seven times with four wins and earnings of \$307,612.

STRONACH PROPOSES GEORGIA TRACK Frank Stronach, owner of GI Belmont S. winner Touch Gold, proposed building a race track and year-round family entertainment center in Georgia. Stronach met with several Georgia state legislators Monday to discuss details of his plan. He told the lawmakers that he would fund the facility entirely by himself at a 400-acre site within a half-hour drive of Atlanta. He intends to include both Thoroughbred and standardbred racing. Currently, Georgia has no pari-mutuel legislation in place.

REWARD DOUBLED IN KENTUCKY SPONGE

Just as the Classic-winning colts were beaten in Tuesday's St James's Palace S., so the Classic-winning fillies Sleepytime (Ire) and CLASSIC PARK (GB) (Robellino), were well beaten here, with Rebecca Sharp fashioning a complete reversal of her 13th finish in the May 4 Newmarket 1000 Guineas. KHASSAH (Green Desert) set the pace from Ocean Ridge and Sleepytime, with Rebecca Sharp settled in behind. At the guarter-mile pole, Khassah still led from Ocean Ridge, but Rebecca Sharp made a strong move on the outside. Sleepytime, boxed in on the rail, failed to make any rally. Inside the final furlong, Rebecca Sharp ran on well to score her second win from four starts. Although the winner started at odds of 25-1, her victory came as no surprise to trainer Geoffrey Wragg. "There was something wrong with her in the 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, but we knew she would run well today." Winning rider Michael Hills said: "The plan was to follow Sleepytime, whom we thought would make the pace, but my brother Richard set the pace on Khassah and we slipped around Sleepytime on the turn and from then on I knew we'd win or be second." Favored Sleepytime's trainer Henry Cecil said "The plan was to make the running, but that never happened. She might have found the going too fast for her."

ADDITION: Bosra Sham (Woodman), who won Wednesday's G2 Prince of Wales's S. at Ascot, was a \$902,969 1994 Tattersalls Houghton Yearling (530,000 guineas), the most expensive yearling sold at public auction in Europe that year.




