CHAMPION SPRINTER SMILE DEAD Smile (In Reality), champion sprinter of 1986, was put down earlier this month after suffering for two years from Equine Protozoal Myelitis. The 15-year-old stallion stood the 1996 season at Dr. Billy Day's Cedar Creek Farm in Texas, but was only able to get two mares in foal. He was sent to Griffith Farm in May, where his health declined further. He was not bred this year. During his racing career, Smile captured the 1986 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and the 1985 GI Arlington Classic. He was second in the 1985 Breeders' Cup Sprint. Smile raced 27 times with 14 wins, four seconds and three thirds for earnings for \$1,664,027.

BREEDERS' CUP TO CHURCHILL IN 1998 Addressing a meeting of shareholders at the Sports Spectrum in Louisville Thursday, track president Thomas Meeker announced that the 1998 Breeders' Cup will be held at Churchill Downs. According to the *Blood-Horse Daily Edition* on-line, Meeker said, "We'll be making a formal announcement within the next couple of weeks." Churchill last hosted the Breeders' Cup in 1994.

Celeric (GB), benefiting from a brilliant ride by Pat Eddery, scored his 11th win from 23 starts in his Group 1 stakes debut. Eddery settled his mount at the back of the field while GREY SHOT (GB) (Sharrood) and 1995 winner DOUBLE TRIGGER (IRE) (Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}) set the pace. DOUBLE ECLIPSE (IRE) (Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}) took over with a half-mile to race only to be challenged and passed by the 1996 winner Classic Cliche (Ire), who went clear of the field and looked the probable winner. But Eddery had brought Celeric through to patiently close on the leader--timing his finishing run to perfection and hitting the front well inside the final furlong. Eddery said: "The trainer let me ride him as I wanted, so I settled him at the back, the way the horse likes to be ridden. He gave me so much confidence. Everything went perfectly. I was not worried when Classic Cliche went clear as I always had plenty of horse. He didn't try and pull himself up when he hit the front, probably because he had no horses around him." Frankie Dettori rode the runner-up and said: "It was good to see Classic Cliche back to his best, just a shame he couldn't win the race for the second year running."

SLEW OF DAMASCUS SIDELINED Millionaire **Slew Of Damascus** (Slewacide) suffered a cracked right front cannon bone during the Rainier Breeders' Cup at Emerald Downs June 15 and will be out of action the rest of the year. Whether the nine-year-old, a Grade I winner of 16 races and \$1,415,300, will return next year is still uncertain. "This is a new injury," said trainer Craig Roberts. "It's not career-ending or life-threatening, but at nine years old, it is definitely a concern. Hopefully he'll be back next year for his last year of racing." The winner of the 1994 GI Hollywood Gold Cup, Slew Of Damascus was unraced in 1996 but came back after a 15-month layoff to finish sixth in a stakes at Bay Meadows March 9. He then captured the Fox Sports Northwest H. at Emerald Downs before running eighth in his final start of the season. Roberts said the gelding would miss about six months of training.

Rain-softened ground undoubtedly helped Yashmak, the Epsom Oaks fourth, to return to the sort of form she showed when galloping home by nine lengths in the Vodafone Fillies Trial at Newbury May 16. She cruised up to join the leader at the quarter-mile mark and stormed clear, extending her lead with every stride to land her third win from seven lifetime starts. Trainer Henry Cecil said: "It was a rough race at Epsom and she was not seen at her best. The softened ground suited her much better today. It's not that I'm good with the ladies, I'm just very lucky to have so many good fillies sent to me by their breeders."

Champion sprinter-elect Royal Applause (GB) returned to the scene of his G3 Coventry S. win in 1995. A disappointment in 1996, he made every yard of the running to run his record to three-for-three this year. Racing down the middle of the track, he was always in command, but only just lasted home from Blue Goblin, ridden by Gary Stevens. Winning trainer Barry Hills said: "This is a very good horse and he has found his best form again this year. He had a great season in 1995, but he lost it last year and wasn't right physically, so at the end of the year he was given three months rest and that did him the world of good. He has such natural speed and ability. He goes next for the G1 July Cup over six furlongs at Newmarket (July 10). Then we might think about the Breeders' Cup Sprint at Hollywood Park." Michael Hills, winning jockey and son of the trainer, said: "He's a speed machine, so exciting to ride. He seemed to enjoy the cut in the ground. He only just got home up that hill and I had to keep the pressure on him. But it would have taken something very special to beat him today."

Springing a 33-1 surprise, Tippitt Boy (GB) gave his trainer Kevin McAuliffe his first Group race win with a battling victory over the pacesetting filly Hopping Higgins (Ire). With the filly still leading a quarter-mile out, BODYGUARD (GB) (Zafonic) tried to come through on the inside, but he would not go for a gap on the rail and in fact hit it with his hindquarters, causing him to duck right and interfere with POOL MUSIC (GB) (). Tippitt Boy and Hopping Higgins avoided the trouble and the race developed between the pair inside the final furlong, with the former just gaining the advantage at the wire. McAuliffe said: "This is the best two-year-old I've had. The plan was always to come to Royal Ascot from the day I bought him. I don't know how he got beaten on his second start at Redcar (May 26), but he came back to win at Warwick (June 4) when he was allowed to bowl along. I thought he needed six furlongs and thought about the Coventry S. on Tuesday, but everyone wants to win that. We decided to run him in this race, which is a stiff five-furlong test, and come late, which is exactly what he did."

Cape Verdi (Ire) was considered the banker bet of the whole meeting after her impressive debut at Newmarket May 31, but she found one too good for her this time. EXBOURNE'S WISH (Exbourne) (10th) set the pace, with Central Park coming to take command at the quarter-mile point; Cape Verdi cruised up on the outside and looked set to justify favouritism, but Frankie Dettori would not be denied on Central Park and the colt turned back the challenge of the filly to score impressively. Owner Prince Fahd Salman was "overwhelmed, at a loss for words. My thanks to trainer Paul Cole, Frankie and my manager Anthony Penfold, who bought the horse. This is wonderful." Dettori added: "This is a good, big horse with a lovely temperament. He enjoyed the ground, too. I think he has a big future."

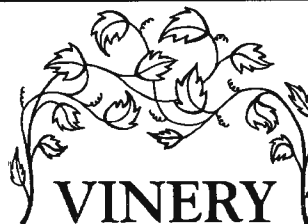

The Eclipse winner worked between races at Hollywood Park Wednesday afternoon, going six furlongs in 1:12 4/5. The five-year-old mare, already a two-time Grade I winner in three starts this year, finished second in the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn in her latest effort April 11. She will make her next appearance in the GI \$250,000 Hempstead H. for fillies and mares at a mile and a sixteenth on Saturday, June 28.
