SILVER CHARM SIZZLES AT CHURCHILL

Breezing for the first time since his second-place finish in the GI Belmont S. June 7, Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) zipped three furlongs in :33 4/5 between the fifth and sixth races at Churchill yesterday afternoon. With jockey Joe Steiner in the irons, the colt went the quarter in :22 2/5 and galloped out the half in :47. "How about that :33 and 4...could we run that Belmont again?" quipped owner Bob Lewis after the move. Silver Charm returned to the winner's circle after the work, where he was presented with a silver basket filled with apples, carrots and peppermints. The colt will make his next start in the GI Buick Haskell Invitational at Monmouth August 3.

DUBAI WORLD CUP EARNS GROUP 1 STATUS

According to yesterday's *Sporting Life*, the Dubai World Cup will be run as a Group 1 event next year. Nad Al Sheba's \$4 million mile-and-a-quarter test was awarded the top grading by the International Cataloguing Standards Committee after only two runnings. It is the first Group race for the United Arab Emirates, which also holds six Listed stakes. "Following the promotion of the principal races of the United Arab Emirates to Listedrace status in 1996, the granting of Group 1 status to the Dubai World Cup from 1998 is confirming the successful development of racing in that country," Louis Romanet, chairman of the ICSC, told *Sporting Life*.

BENNY THE DIP TO TAKE ON BOSRA SHAM

Epsom Derby winner Benny The Dip (Silver Hawk), who had been expected to aim for next Sunday's Budweiser Irish Derby and a much-anticipated rematch with the colt he beat at Epsom, Silver Patriarch (Ire) (Saddlers' Hall {Ire}}, is now likely to skip the race. The three-yearold will instead clash with Europe's champion filly Bosra Sham (Woodman), brilliant winner of the G2 Prince Of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot, in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown Park on July 5. Benny The Dip's trainer John Gosden said Saturday: "The colt's owner-breeder, Landon Knight, takes the view that his best trip is a mile and a quarter. The horse will love Sandown. It's a great front-runner's track and he will be able to kick off the bend. Obviously I would prefer it if Bosra Sham missed the Eclipse and went straight to the King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 26, but Benny The Dip will be receiving weight from her."

Ajina ended her two-year-old campaign with a dominant seven-length tally in the GII Demoiselle S. at Aqueduct in November but had been unable to reproduce that form in her first four starts at three. A well-beaten third behind Sharp Cat in the GI Acorn S. last time she ran May 31, the dark bay homebred was ignored at 18-1 but came to life, stalking the Acorn winner through rapid early fractions before putting a head in front as they straightened for home and then edging clear in the final furlong. "This is such a big surprise, especially in a tough race like this," said trainer Bill Mott. "Going into the race, I wasn't too sure if (Ajina) was going to be able to outrun Sharp Cat, but we really weren't left with many options. I guess we'll have to chalk this one up to luck. What a pleasant surprise." Mott added the Coaching Club American Oaks at Belmont July 19 could be next for the filly. The runner-up, now 0-for-three at a mile and an eighth, set the pace but could not hold on. "I thought we got away with realistic fractions, so I thought we were in good shape," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "But (Ajina) tracked us in a good spot and had a better day than us." Sharp Cat is also possible for
