FREE HOUSE WORKS; TOUCH GOLD BREAKS

OUT Free House (Smokester), third in the Kentucky Derby and Belmont S. and second in the Preakness S., was sent out to the track yesterday morning for his first work since the June 7 Belmont S., while Belmont winner **Touch Gold** (Deputy Minister) provided his connections with a few anxious moments after breaking loose in the Hollywood stable area. Free House drilled five furlongs in 1:00 with exercise rider Sal Gonzalez up. Trainer Paco Gonzalez caught the grey colt through fractions of :25 2/5, :36 4/5 and :48 1/5 along the way. "I actually had him in :59 4/5," Gonzalez said. "He galloped out in 1:13 2/5. It was just what I wanted him to do. The track is a little fast today, but he went really good and did everything right." Gonzalez and owners Trudy McCaffery and John Toffan have not made a final decision as to where Free House will start next. The Gonzalez stable was quick to help out when Triple Crown rival Touch Gold got loose after a Sunday morning gallop. The three-year-old's break-out was cut short when one of Gonzalez's hotwalkers caught the colt. "If we hadn't caught him, he would have been running around who knows where," Gonzalez said. Yesterday, Touch Gold made his second trip to the track since the Belmont win and afterward briefly got loose in the walking ring next to the ring Gonzalez uses. The two outfits are stabled next to each other. Touch Gold is scheduled to work next weekend, his first breeze since defeating Silver Charm and Free House in the Belmont.

French Derby hero Peintre Celebre lived up to owner Daniel Wildenstein's description of being "the best colt I have had, by far" in taking his third win in three starts this season impressively at Longchamp yesterday. The three-year-old colt showed no signs of fatigue from his G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) win at Chantilly June 1, settling nicely under jockey Olivier Peslier in fourth position. Turning for home, Peintre Celebre, who had always remained in striking position, moved up to join the leaders and drew away from them to win by a comfortable two lengths. Winning trainer Andre Fabre said "Peintre Celebre did not show the same brilliance and sharp acceleration as in the French Derby. This was probably due to the very soft ground. At home he has only done one piece of poor work and this was also on the soft ground. Olivier Peslier did not have to give him a hard race as he was by far the best horse in the race. I will have to discuss his future races with his owner Daniel Wildenstein, but he is entered in the King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot on June 26th."

Listening took the GII Bayakoa H. last December but had been unable to find the winner's circle in four starts since, finishing third in the May 25 GII Hawthorne H. in her last start. The grey filly stalked the pacesetters before rallying three wide turning for home to take the lead with authority and draw off. "We were very fortunate to get the trip we did," said winning jockey Alex Solis. "We were right where we wanted to be. We saved some ground on the first turn, then I got her out and got my position on the backside. We just waited for those two in front of us to get tired." The win gave trainer Ron McAnally a record six victories in the Milady and was bittersweet after the passing of the McAnally-trained dual Milady winner Bayakoa last week. "She was a great mare," the trainer said of Bayakoa. "She's hard to replace. At least this filly here has done very well for us."

Frisk Me Now, a 105-1 shocker winning the Feb. 2 GII Hutcheson S., came into this effort off of a fifth-place showing in the May 17 GI Preakness S. The third choice was sent straight to the front while being stalked by Anet down the backside. Anet moved up to challenge for the lead at the top of the stretch but Frisk Me Now surged ahead in the final strides for the victory. "At the 3/16th pole, the other horse (Anet) got by me, by a neck," winning rider Eddie King, Jr. said. "It was about time we made the lead switch so we were OK. All my thoughts were of getting that neck back from the other lane, just getting back in front of him. At the 1/4 pole, I saw Anet at my heels, he got passed there but I didn't let him stay there." Winning trainer Robert Durso said that the addition of blinkers may or may not have been a factor in victory. "When he gets bumped, he becomes more aggressive," he said. "When he is by himself, he gets lackadaisical, he is kind of a laid back horse."
