HOLLYWOOD PARK POISED TO PROVIDE CLASSIC COMPETITION

Hollywood Park officials are close to finalizing plans for a new stakes race that could be an attractive alternative to the Breeders' Cup Classic for horses not originally nominated to the championship events. The as-yet unnamed race would be run November 30--on the same card as the GI Matriarch and GI Crown Royal Hollywood Derby--and already has the support of the Thoroughbred Owners of California. The weight-for-age event would fall three weeks after the Breeders' Cup and could conceivably entice such stars as Silver Charm, Skip Away, Sandpit, Siphon and Gentlemen, all of whom were not supplemented to the Breeders' Cup at birth. In order to run in the Breeders' Cup Classic, the connections of those runners would be forced to pay between \$480,000 and \$800,000. The Breeders' Cup has traditionally decided championships, so the deflection of a number of racing's major stars to the new Hollywood Park race could have a strong impact on divisional battles and on balloting for Horse of the Year honors. The issue of supplemental nominations to the Breeders' Cup came to the fore last year after Skip Away beat Cigar in the Jockey Club Gold Cup. A rematch never materialized after the then-three-year-old's connections decided not to pay the supplemental fee. Skip Away was a distant second to Cigar in Horse of the Year balloting.
