BATTLE WAGES ON FOR TRIPLE CROWN STARS

In yet another effort to lure the stars of the 1997 Triple Crown, Monmouth Park officials yesterday announced that the owner of this year's Buick Haskell Invitational winner could earn an extra \$250,000 on top of the winner's share of the \$1,000,000 purse. A bonus of \$250,000 will be available if the Haskell winner has a Grade I victory to his or her credit from January 1 to August 2 of this year and there are two or more 1997 Grade I winners in the Haskell field. A bonus of \$150,000 will be offered if there is just one 1997 Grade I winner in the field, and he (or she) wins the August 3 race. Belmont winner **Touch Gold** (Deputy Minister); runner-up **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck), first in the Kentucky Derby and Preakness; and Belmont third **Free House** (Smokester), victorious in the Santa Anita Derby, are all eligible for the bonuses. But Hollywood Park has battled back, moving the date of the Gil Swaps S. from July 13 to July 20. Despite that move, Silver Charm is still headed to the Jersey Shore and the Haskell; the connections of the other two colts have yet to make a commitment.

TOP JOCKS CONVERGE ON LONE STAR

Twelve of the country's top riders, including seven Hall of Famers, will be at Lone Star Park in Grand Prairie, Texas tonight for the first-ever National All-Star Jockey Championship. The \$100,000 event showcases Hall of Fame reinsmen Jerry Bailey, Pat Day, Eddie Delahoussaye, Chris McCarron, Laffit Pincay Jr., 1997 inductee Gary Stevens and Jorge Velasquez, who will ride head-to-head in a single race for the first time. Also set to compete are Mike Smith, Kent Desormeaux, Shane Sellers and Lone Star leaders Ronald Ardoin and Marlon St. Julien. The fields for the four Championship races (second, fourth, fifth and seventh on the card) have been divided into four groups--A, B, C and D--with the three morning-line favorites in Group A, down to the three longest shots in Group D. Riding assignments, drawn at random, assure that each rider will have one mount in each group. Points will be awarded to the top finishers in each race, and the rider who earns the most points over the four races will pick up the top prize of \$25,000. One percent of the handle on the four races will be donated to the Jockey's Guild.

EPSOM DERBY T.V. VIEWERS TOP 6 MILLION

Britain's CHANNEL 4 was scheduled to announce yesterday that the audience for its television coverage of the June 7 Vodafone Epsom Derby exceeded six million, according to a report in Thursday's *Sporting Life*. The channel's original estimate of 3.6 million increased with the addition of viewers of the 30-minute highlights show and of people who watched the event in pubs and clubs. Viewership of last year's Derby totaled 2.6 million and Vodafone had threatened to withdraw its sponsorship of the race if that number did not increase this year.
