HOLLYWOOD UPS SWAPS ANTE Just after announcing they would move the GII Swaps S. from July 13 to July 20, Hollywood Park officials and the Thoroughbred Owners of California yesterday issued a release stating they would also raise the purse from \$500,000 to \$700,000 if two of the first three finishers from this year's Belmont S, run in the race. The track have already offered a \$500,000 bonus to the winner of the Swaps should Belmont hero Touch Gold (Deputy Minister), runner-up Silver Charm (Silver Buck) and thirdplace finisher Free House (Smokester) all compete. "Not only is this an attractive package, it provides an opportunity to run at Hollywood Park before we hold the Breeders' Cup here in November." said Hollywood Park Chairman R.D. Hubbard, Silver Charm, currently the top three-year-old after winning both the Kentucky Derby and Preakness, is still committed to starting in the GI Buick Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park August 3.

WILD ESCAPADE RETIRED GISW Wild Escapade (Wild Again), winner of the GI Hopeful S. at two, suffered a minor injury to his right rear suspensory ligament and has been retired. "Suspensory and soft tissue injuries are very tricky," said trainer Stephen Dunn. "Some horses come back well and some don't. In fairness to the horse, we had to let him go out on a good note. He couldn't do much else to help him in his stud career." A winner over Churchill allowance foes in his final two career starts, the five-year-old set a new track record in his very last outing June 4, running six-and-a-half furlongs in 1:15 2/5. Purchased as a stud prospect by Joseph Barbazon for \$82,000 from the 1996 Keeneland November Sale, the bay goes to the breeding shed with a record of six wins from 37 starts and earnings of \$342,996. Plans for his stud career have not yet been finalized.
