UNBRIDLED'S SONG JOINS ARROWFIELD

SHUTTLE CLUB Millionaire Unbridled's Song (Unbridled), winner of the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and GI Florida Derby, will join the roster of stallions at Australia's Arrowfield Stud for the 1997 Southern Hemisphere breeding season. Arrowfield is also purchasing a share in the four-year-old, who stood his first season at Kentucky's Taylor Made Farm this spring. "I am thrilled that Arrowfield has become a partner in Unbridled's Song," said Arrowfield's John Messara. "I regard him as an absolutely outstanding prospect. He is just a magnificent individual, so correct, with a great pedigree and freakish ability. He can make a real difference in Australia." Added Ben Taylor of Taylor Made Farm, "Unbridled's Song bred an awesome book of mares in his first season in Kentucky. He is a very fertile horse and a professional breeder. Taylor Made is pleased to enter the Australian equine industry with such a quality stallion and a quality partner in Arrowfield."

GARY STEVENS STARS AT LONE STAR Can his first Eclipse Award be far behind? In a year that already includes induction into the Hall of Fame, victories in the Kentucky Derby and Preakness and a Group stakes win at England's prestigious Royal Ascot meeting, jockey Gary Stevens added yet another honor Friday night, outriding the best in the country to take the \$100,000 National All-Star Jockey Championship at Lone Star Park in Grand Prairie, Texas, Picking up 14 points over the four-race competition, Stevens finished just two points ahead of fellow Hall of Famer Chris McCarron. "This is the first time in my career that... I felt like I had a fan base," said Stevens. "People were really rooting for Gary Stevens. You could feel the tension in the air and a lot of excitement out there. I think it put on a really good show for the people. I know I had fun." Stevens earned his All-Star victory, and top prize of \$25,000, with third-place finishes in the first two legs of the event and a second-place finish in the third. After McCarron, who won the second of four Championship races, the complete order of finish was Mike Smith, first in the final leg; Jerry Bailey, who took the opener; Pat Day, winner of the third; Ronald Ardoin; Eddie Delahoussaye; Kent Desormeaux; Marlon St. Julien; Shane Sellers; Laffit Pincay Jr.; and Jorge Velasquez. Hidden Lake finished a close second in the May 3 GIII Humana Distaff H. at Churchill and then switched barns to John Kimmel and responded with a victory in the May 24 GII Shuvee H. in her previous start. The third choice raced close to the pace before taking over when asked and drawing away in the stretch. "She's really starting to come into her own," winning jockey Richard Migliore said. "She is so good right now that it is scary. I knew that we were going against some of the top fillies around, but I believed that they would have to run their best in order to beat us." Trainer John Kimmel indicated the winner will be shipped to Saratoga, ultimately pointing for the Breeders' Cup Distaff. Twice the Vice, making her second start of 1997, raced just behind the pace in third and drifted wide for the stretch drive but could not catch the winner. "My filly ran a great race, and I really thought I had the winner anytime I wanted her," Chris McCarron, rider aboard Twice the Vice, said. "We got into the lane, I cut my filly loose and I said to myself, 'Man, I got it now.' But then I looked up and said, 'Hey, this is where Hidden Lake is supposed to back up,' and she didn't." Favored Jewel Princess, who was coming off a second-place finish in the Apr. 11 Gl Apple Blossom H., raced at the back of the pack early and then made a strong inside rally to get third. Twice The Vice and Jewel Princess are scheduled to meet again in the July 20 GI Vanity H.

"He runs his best races on the lead," winning jockey Jean-Luc Samyn said, "so it was an easy decision to put him on the front. Turning for home, I just talked to him a couple of times, hand rode him a little bit; I went to the stick at the eighth-pole just in case those big finishers were coming at me, but I didn't see anybody coming." Added winning owner Michael Becker, who went through a two-year recovery after being hit by an 18wheel truck, "He (Influent) runs for handicapped kids. We donate one percent of his earnings to the Winslow Therapy Riding Academy for handicapped kids in Warwick, New York." Geri, who was making his second career turf start, tracked the leader in second the entire way.
