**BOLD 'N DETERMINED DEAD** Bold 'n Determined (Bold and Brave), a multiple Grade I winner of \$949,599 who will be inducted into racing's Hall of Fame this year, had to be put down Tuesday at Gainsborough Farm in Versailles, Kentucky due to complications from founder. The 20-year-old won 16 of her 20 career starts; her six Grade I wins as a three-year-old included the Kentucky Oaks, Coaching Club American Oaks, Acorn and Spinster. Barren for 1997 and in foal to Sunny's Halo at the time of her death, the mare produced 12 foals, six of them winners. Her most accomplished foal was the filly Happy Holiday, a Group 2 winner in Argentina by Turkoman. Bold 'n Determined has a yearling colt and an unraced two-year-old colt, Prompt Delivery, both by Zilzal. She was buried at Gainsborough Farm.
