INDEPENDENCE DAY DISPLAY BY SKIP AWAY

The whisper was he just wasn't the same. After his first four starts of the season, last year's top three-year-old **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) was still without a win and the title he very nearly snagged last year, that left behind by two-time Horse of the Year Cigar, was up for grabs. But with his impressive win in yesterday's GI \$350,000 Suburban H. at Belmont Park, the champ gave notice he is back in the running. Beaten a half-length by the best in the west, Gentlemen (Arg), in the GI Pimlico Special, the grey came back to take the GIII Massachusetts H. in a game effort May 31. He made it two in a row in the Suburban, sweeping to the lead at the head of the stretch and drawing off to win by a length and a half as the even-money favorite. "I have a lot of confidence in Skip Away," said winning rider Shane Sellers. "I knew if he was clear and had something to run at, he would fire. I know that when I call on him, he's going to deliver." The colt will make his next start in the GI Whitney S. at Saratoga August 2.

TOUCH GOLD POINTS FOR HASKELL After having a planned workout postponed yet again Friday, Belmont S. winner **Touch Gold** (Deputy Minister) will definitely miss the GI Swaps S. July 20 and instead get ready for a rematch with the Belmont runner-up, Derby and Preakness winner **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck), in the GI Buick Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park August 3. Trainer David Hofmans said yesterday he is still concerned with the quarter crack on the colt's left front hoof. "We're not happy with how the foot is doing," said Hofmans. "Right now, the patch is off it and we're letting it air out. The Haskell is his next likely start."

Making good on the promise he has shown in his last two starts, last year's Eclipse Award-winning three-year-old Skip Away followed a gallant photo finish win in the GIII Mass 'Cap May 31 with a more dominant performance here. Bet down to even money despite the narrow score over subsequent Brooklyn H. winner Formal Gold at Suffolk Downs, the striking grey colt was on the lead early, dropped back to fourth while hard-held after three-quarters in 1:12.15, then came with a three-wide bid at the top of the lane to take command and draw clear. "Now I know if this didn't work out, people would be saying the jockey was an idiot for letting those other horses go by," said winning rider Shane Sellers. "But you have to realize that I know Skip Away like the back of my hand. Sonny (Hine) wanted me to be off the rail, and neither of us wanted to be on the lead. I had plenty of horse and plenty of run." Runner-up Will's Way put a head in front after a mile and held the lead until the stretch, then gave way grudgingly. "What more can you say? He tried his best," said trainer Jim Bond. "He seemed to be running strong down the stretch--he just got outrun at the end." The top two will now head to Saratoga and the GI Whitney S. August 2, while third-placed Formal Gold will get a break, then point for the GI Iselin H. at Monmouth August 23.

El Angelo won three of his first four starts this season, including the Gill Inglewood H., but then ran into a traffic jam in the Gill Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile and ended up sixth. Bet down to even-money here, the dark bay raced off the rail in fourth down the backstretch, switched to the inside on the final turn, then came back out for the stretch drive and rallied to get the lead late and edge clear. "I was really disappointed after the Shoemaker," said trainer Jenine Sahadi. "I really felt he didn't get an opportunity to run. Running him right back like this is a little sooner than I normally do, but I figured that I would have some time between this and the Eddie Read (at Del Mar August 3). It worked out well." Irish Wings (Ire), who suffers from allergies, was scratched after coughing the morning of the race. He will be turned out at owner Edmund Gann's farm with an eye toward a return at Del Mar.
