HASKELL NEXT? She earned her first graded stakes win in the GIII Fair Grounds Oaks in March, her first Grade I triumph in the Kentucky Oaks in May and James and Sue Burns' Blushing K.D. (Blushing John) added the GII Monmouth Park Breeders' Cup Oaks to the forest with a 4 1/2-length score vesterday. Looking to rebound from a lackluster fourth-place finish in the GII Black-Eyed Susan May 16, the Foxfield-bred filly was bet down to 2-5 and had no trouble living up to those odds, stalking the pace through six furlongs in 1:10 4/5, taking command on the far turn and drawing off at will. "Her problem was that she had a depleted potassium level," winning trainer Sam David Jr. said of the filly's effort in the Black-Eyed Susan. "She had lost her get up and go, but now she has it back. We felt we had her problem straightened out. She showed all the signs that she is okay." As for future plans, David said, "We really love it here at Monmouth Park. We plan on leaving the filly here for the next couple of weeks. She is possible for the Haskell. We'll see how we come out of this race and take a look." The filly would take on colts for the second time in the GI Buick Haskell Invitational August 3; she dusted a restricted field in the Fair Grounds Sales Derby in February, winning by 20 lengths.

FREE HOUSE SHARP AT HOLLYWOOD Top three-year-old Free House (Smokester), on the board in all three Triple Crown races this year, worked six furlongs in 1:12 3/5 at Hollywood Saturday morning and could make his next start in the GII \$500,000 Swaps S. July 20. "This is his home and he loves this track," said his trainer, Paco Gonzalez. "I think there's a very good chance we'll stay here and run in the Swaps, but the owners (Trudy McCaffery and John Toffan) haven't decided yet. Personally I'd like to run him here and then go to the Travers (at Saratoga August 23)." The grey, winner of this year's GI Santa Anita Derby, was third in the GI Belmont S. June 7 in his last start.

Breeders' Cup Turf hero Pilsudski (Ire) adds the Coral-Eclipse S. to his list of accomplishments, beating hot favorite Bosra Sham. The five-year-old made it a third victory in the race for trainer Michael Stoute, who also won it in 1993 with Ezzoud (Ire) and again in 1994 with Opera House (GB). English Derby hero Benny The Dip led the field at a very steady pace, with Pilsudski and iockey Mick Kinane always in a striking position. Kinane eased his mount past the pacesetter two furlongs out and ran on to win comfortably. Bosra Sham had traffic problems when following the leaders; she tried to find a gap along the rail which never opened wide enough and had to switch for a run along the outside, just missing second. The victory of Pilsudski was tinged with sadness for owner Lord Weinstock, whose son bred the horse but tragically died last year before the horse had reached his full potential. " I hope that he is watching the race somewhere and I know he would have been very pleased," said Weinstock. Trainer Michael Stoute added: "It has been a great day and that was a very good performance. He is a big horse and takes a lot of winding up to reach his peak form. He was not quite ready for Ascot when he finished second in the Hardwicke S., but he was in peak form this afternoon." Pilsudski will have one more summer race and then point for the Arc at Longchamp October 5. Runner-up Benny The Dip's jockey Willie Ryan said, "I was very pleased with my horse. He showed great courage to battle against Bosra Sham and land second place. I felt that he ran a bigger race than in the Epsom Derby."

Treated for low potassium levels discovered in a blood test following the race, the filly was back on track as the odds-on choice here. The favorite stalked the early pace before taking the lead entering the far turn and then pulling away in the stretch while being ridden out. "Up the backstretch, she spotted that horse on the lead (Semaphore Ms.) and wanted to go by," winning jockey Lonnie Meche said, "She was running really easy, and I knew that horse on the lead had never gone two turns, so I expected her to tire. When I turned for home I knew I had a lot of horse. I was pretty confident we had the race won."



Behrens won a Jan. 18 Gulfstream maiden race by 4 3/4 lengths and then came back off a four-month lavoff to capture a May 24 Belmont allowance race by three lengths. Making his stakes debut in his third start, the second choice settled in good position early, edged closer while racing three-wide around the far turn and then ran past Glitman in the final stages to remain undefeated. "This horse has got a lot of talent and he keeps on impressing everyone," winning jockey Jerry Bailey said. "He's been a lightly raced horse...to beat these types of horses is really something." Added trainer H. James Bond, "He's just an outstanding horse and he keeps on proving it to us. The scary thing is that he's still only learning to run." The winner will likely race next in the Aug. 3 GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga, Favored Banker's Gold, who also brought a perfect record into this race, sat just off the pace through the opening fractions and lacked a late response in what was his first stakes start. "I expected this horse to make one big run like he did last time, and that didn't happen," said trainer Allen Jerkens. "Now I don't know what we'll do next. I thought I had the best colt, now I don't know."
