LABEEB BACK ON TRACK GISW Labeeb (GB) (Lear Fan), who was four-for-five in the U.S. with one second before dropping his rider in the GI Manhattan H. last out June 7, is back at trainer Neil Drysdale's barn after spending several days schooling with trainer Karl Webster. The lightly raced five-year-old, who has on occasion refused to work in the mornings, had behaved perfectly in the afternoon prior to the Manhattan, winning the GI Hollywood Derby in 1995, going two-for-two in 1996 and then taking the GII El Rincon H. and finishing second in the GI Early Times Turf Classic in his two prior outings this year. But in his first start at Belmont Park, the talented but temperamental turf star took a right-hand turn while making his run at the top of the stretch and unseated jockey John Velazguez. "We've been kind of starting over with him," said Drysdale. "We're getting his confidence back. We only kept him at Karl's barn for three days. We thought a change of scenery would do him some good." Added Webster, "We had a little trouble with him on the turf course, but I got after him and he's been going along well." The bay, who started his career in France and is now five-for-14 lifetime with earnings of \$507,039, worked three furlongs in :39 3/5 over the Hollywood turf July 3. He is expected to make his next start in the GI Eddie Read H. at Del Mar August 3.

SUCCESSFUL SURGERY FOR SAVINIO Savinio (The Minstrel), a MGSW of \$1,115,899, underwent surgery on his left eye Wednesday after suffering an injury when second in the GIII Golden Gate H. last out June 8, but the seven-year-old is expected to make a full recovery. "It was a recurrence of an old injury he suffered in the 1995 American H.," said trainer Walter Greenman. "He got a whip in the eye by another jockey in the race. We'll remove the stitches in two weeks. He'll be fine."


