SUFFOLK DOWNS SOLD After negotiating for three years and signing a purchase and sales agreement almost a year ago, James B. Moseley and John Hall's Sterling Suffolk Racecourse announced yesterday that the company has purchased Suffolk Downs from Edward G. "Buddy" LeRoux's Belle Isle Limited Partnership. Sterling Suffolk reopened the Massachusetts racetrack in 1992 after leasing two-thirds of the property from Belle Island in 1991. "For the past six years we have made strides toward reclaiming the wonderful history of this facility and ensuring the strong future of the local Thoroughbred racing industry," said Moseley, chairman of Suffolk Downs. "While we have made progress, there was the danger under the lease that we would not be the beneficiaries of our own work. This is no longer the case. This is a positive step for the horsemen, the breeders, the Massachusetts horse farms, the backstretch workers, our labor force here at the track--the thousands who depend on racing at Suffolk Downs for their livelihood." The cost of the facility, which stands on 190 acres in East Boston and Revere, was a \$30 million base price and a \$10 million second note.

KHBPA COMES TO AID OF SPONGED HORSE

The Kentucky Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association is providing financial assistance to John Brenzel, who claimed the "sponged" horse **Class O Lad** (Ormonte) out of a race at Churchill Downs June 14. The horse suffered severe respiratory distress from the sponges which had been inserted in his nasal passages prior to that race, and subsequently foundered. "He is really in a day-to-day situation," said Bill Million, who now trains the six-year-old gelding. "He is such a classy horse with a real even disposition. We have consulted three veterinarians in an effort to save him. We're hoping for the best." Added Marty Maline, the KHBPA Executive Director, "The KHBPA Board recognized that claiming racehorses is a risky proposition, and normally financial help would not be considered. But in the case of Class O Lad, it has been well documented that he is the victim of a criminal act. Based on the circumstances surrounding the situation, the Board members felt it is appropriate to make an exception."

South African champion **London News (SAf)** (Bush Telegraph {SAf}), third to Bosra Sham in the Prince Of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot and then fifth and last in the G2 Budweiser American Bowl International S. at The Curragh last out June 29, is on his way home according to yesterday's *Racing Post*. His English trainer Barry Hills told the *Post*, "London News is now in quarantine and goes back to South Africa when that's complete. When arriving home he'll go into a second quarantine station and then return to his trainer, Alec Laird."

Raratonga Treat (Aus) (Geiger Counter), rated midpack early, swept to the lead in the straight and galloped way to a four-length victory over the filly **Igreja (Arg)** (Southern Halo) in the G1 Premier's Champion S. in Greyville, South Africa Saturday. Now the odds-on favorite to take the two-year-old championship in South Africa, the colt becomes the second Australian-bred Group 1 winner this season for Geiger Counter (Mr. Prospector), who stands at Australia's Arrowfield Stud.

An immediate reaction to the surprise defeat of **Bosra Sham** (Woodman) in Saturday's Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown Park has been yesterday's reported 'sacking' of jockey Kieren Fallon by Syrian businessman Wafic Said, who owns the champion filly. Fallon admitted after the Eclipse that he had ridden a poor race on Bosra Sham, getting her into traffic trouble in the five-horse field, and neither owner nor trainer Henry Cecil would offer him any words of consolation.
