### PRINCE KHALED ABDULLAH WINS FIVE AT

**NEWMARKET Ryafan** (Lear Fan) and **Bold Fact** (Known Fact) landed the two Group races on the program as owner/breeder Prince Khaled Abdullah enjoyed five winners from six runners at Newmarket Wednesday. The other successful Abdullah runners were **Light Programme** (El Gran Senor), **Memorise** (Lyphard) and **Media Star** (Lear Fan), all homebred. The victorious owner said: "I don't think I have ever had a treble on one day before, so five...I wasn't even intending to come racing today, but I changed my mind." When asked about his ever-expanding operation, Abdullah replied: "It is much more fun to breed and race winners yourself, rather than buying them--less expensive, too. We try and cull our horses each year. It's difficult to part with members of some families, but we do sell a few. But the operation just gets bigger and bigger." Jockey Kieren Fallon, who was fired as the rider of the champion filly Bosra Sham only Monday, bounced back by riding the three Abdullah winners trained by Henry Cecil, as well as another on the card for Cecil. "It never entered my head that I would lose my job (as stable jockey for Cecil) and it's great to have Mr. Cecil's support. Worse things have happened and worse things will probably happen in the future," said Fallon.

**CHARLES TAYLOR DEAD** Windfields Farm president Charles Taylor died Monday evening in Ontario, Canada. The 62-year-old, inducted into the Canadian Racing Hall of Fame in 1996, had been suffering from cancer for the past several years. Taylor succeeded his late father and Windfields founder E.P. Taylor as president of the farm in 1980. But due to his declining health, the Windfields breeding and racing stock were dispersed last fall. Before focusing on Thoroughbred racing, Taylor established a career as a journalist and author. He wrote five non-fiction books and was the bureau chief for Toronto's *Globe and Mail* in Peking, Hong Kong, Nairobi and London.

Royal Applause will start a warm favorite after winning all three starts this year, including the G2 Duke Of York S. May 15 and G3 Cork & Orrery S. at Royal Ascot June 19. Bahamian Bounty was one of Europe's top juveniles last year, winning the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville in August and the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket in late September, but was only sixth in the French 2000 Guineas at Longchamp May 11.

**TATTERSALLS JULY SALE FIGURES UP** Tattersalls's 1997 July Sales concluded yesterday in Newmarket, England with figures up across the board from last year's sale. One hundred and nine horses were sold at yesterday's second day of the sale for a total of \$1,977,827. That's up 27.4 percent from the 1996 second-day total of \$1,552,859 when 104 horses were sold. The average sale price was \$18,519--up 24 percent from last year's average of \$14,931. The sales topper was hip number 282, **Tularosa (GB)** (In the Wings--Topsy, by Habitat). The three-year-old filly-in-training, a half sister to GSW **Most Welcome** (Be My Guest), was consigned by Ecurie H. Pantall, France, agent for Darley Stud Management Co. Ltd. and brought a final bid of \$154,867 from Brian Grassick Bloodstock. "The July Sale has gone from strength to strength in recent years," said Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony. "There has genuinely been something for everyone this week and that has been reflected in the diversity of buyers."

Ryafan, winner of last October's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac, finally scored on her third attempt this year and became owner Prince Khaled Abdullah's fourth straight winner of the day at Newmarket (see *News Today*). The 4-1 chance drove down the straight to catch favored Ocean Ridge in the closing stages. Fourth in the Irish 1000 Guineas May 24 and again in the Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 8, the filly was under strong pressure at the quarter-mile mark, but, racing uphill inside the final furlong, Ocean Ridge's stride shortened and Ryafan found another gear and ran on strongly, appearing to need even further than this mile. Her trainer John Gosden said: "The Nassau S. over a mile and a quarter at Goodwood (August 2) is her next target. I was worried about the fast ground, but she handled it well. It is great to have her back to her best since the French Oaks. Her owner has been very patient and hopefully he will reap the benefit now, as she was totally wrong in her coat in the spring due to the weather." G1 Coronation S. winner Rebecca Sharp appeared to be traveling well at the quarter-mile pole but she faded badly and beat just one horse.

Prince Khaled Abdullah's second winner of the day, Bold Fact duly justified even-money favoritism but once again nearly threw the race away. Just as he had done when losing the G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 17, he raced in the rear early on, came smoothly through to challenge for the lead at the quarter-mile mark, only to swerve badly to his right. But once he was racing along the stands rail he ran straight as a die and galloped home to win comfortably from Linden Heights (GB), who raced all alone on the other side of the track. Trainer Henry Cecil said: "I cannot understand why he swerves like that. He's a sweet little horse and runs perfectly straight at home on the gallops. We need to get him drawn against the rails ideally. There is no particular target in mind for him, I will discuss it with the owner." Cecil's stable jockey Kieren Fallon said: "He did the same as he did in the Coventry S., even though he was wearing a different type of bit today. I half-expected it to happen and was ready for it. As soon as he hit the front, he swerved to the right. If a horse wants to do it, he will. He is probably immature and will grow out of it. He is physically perfect, so greenness is the only explanation."
