### BREEDERS' CUP CHANGES

**SUPPLEMENTAL ENTRY POLICY** Officials of Breeders' Cup Ltd. yesterday announced a new policy for horses supplemented to the Breeders' Cup Championship Day races. For the first time, supplemental entry fees will be added to the purses of Breeders' Cup events. Additionally, a credit system has been established for horses supplemented to the Breeders' Cup. Owners of horses who were not nominated to the Breeders' Cup program as foals will continue to pay a 12-percent supplemental fee, with 10 percent added to the purse and the remaining 2 percent going to Breeders' Cup Ltd. For example, an owner supplementing a horse to the \$1 million Sprint will pay \$120,000, with \$100,000 augmenting the purse of the race and \$20,000 retained by Breeders' Cup Ltd. Owners of horses whose sires were not nominated to the program will continue to pay a 20-percent supplemental fee, with 18 percent going to the purse and 2 percent to the Breeders' Cup. That percentage of the supplemental entry fees which is added to the purse will also be credited against supplemental fees required to enter a horse in future Championship races, regardless of ownership. Once a horse has accumulated a credit equaling the supplemental fee, it will be eligible to run after paying the standard entry fees. "We believe that adjustments to the purse structure regarding supplements and establishing a credit system against future supplements is a positive change which will provide long-term benefits to the Breeders' Cup Championship," said D. G. Van Clief, Jr., president of Breeders' Cup Ltd. "The supplemental question has been a matter of debate for many years. We believe these changes will continue to strengthen the quality of our Championship, while at the same time maintaining the integrity of the nomination process." **WOODMAN IS NEWEST SHUTTLE STALLION**

Woodman (Mr. Prospector) is the newest addition to the already impressive 1997 stallion roster at Coolmore Australia. The 14-year-old stallion, who stands the Northern Hemisphere season at Ashford Stud in Versailles, Kentucky, will join Danehill, Eagle Eyed, Fairy King, Hennessy, Honour and Glory, Last Tycoon (Ire), Royal Academy, Sri Pekan and Thunder Gulch at the New South Wales stud for the 1997 Southern Hemisphere season. Woodman's stud fee will be \$50,000 Australian (\$37,389 U.S.), the second highest in Australia after Danehill at \$100,000 Australian (\$74,778 U.S.). Woodman, the Champion Two-Year-Old Colt in Ireland in 1985, has sired over 40 stakes winners and the earners of more than \$20 million, including champions Hansel, Timber Country, Hector Protector, Bosra Sham, Mujtahid and Hishi Akebono. He is having a career year in 1997, and according to the July 12 *Blood-Horse*, leads all stallions by 1997 International Earnings with \$4,084,128.

**FREE HOUSE DRILLS; NEXT START**

**UNDECIDED** Triple Crown standout **Free House** (Smokester) breezed six furlongs in 1:12 4/5 at Hollywood Park yesterday morning, but a decision as to where the eye-catching grey will make his next start has not yet been made. The colt, second in the GI Preakness and third in the GI Kentucky Derby and most recently the GI Belmont S. June 7, galloped out seven furlongs in 1:25 with regular exercise rider Sal Gonzalez Sr. aboard. "He went very good," said trainer Paco Gonzalez. "I'm getting ready for the Swaps, in case that's the decision." Free House will head for either the GII Swaps S. at Hollywood July 20 or the GI Buick Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park August 3. "I'd like to stay and run here," said Gonzalez. "It gives us more time before the Travers (at Saratoga August 23)."

**WRITERS UP**
**A FRESH LOOK AT THE 1997 FRESHMEN**

It's put-your-money-where-your-mouth-is time for the group of 120-odd stallions in North America, England, Ireland and France whose first foals are two-year-olds of 1997. Fittingly, the first pair of juvenile stakes run at Belmont Park fell to runners by the two freshman sires who were already leading the North American pack in number of winners: Gilded Time and Belong to Me. First Jersey Girl, one of five winners by New York-based Belong to Me, won the Astoria, followed by the victory of Time Limit, one of four winners by Gilded Time, in the Tremont. Go to the head of the class, you two.

Gilded Time is one of three major first-crop sires from the successful Vinery sire factory--the other two are Marquetry and Strike the Gold. No less than 193 yearlings by these three found their way to the sales last year. That's out of 238 foals for the three combined--an average of nearly 65 yearlings sold from nearly 80 foals each. These guys do work for a living. Thus far, Gilded Time has had 13 starters; his winners also include Gilded Statue, who by all accounts was in the process of running a big race when she bucked shins in the Landaluce S. at Hollywood Park and, understandably, trailed home last. However you want to dissect it, Gilded Time is making very much the right sort of start.

Which he was entitled to do. After all, he was four-for-four as a two-year-old, setting a track record of 1:07 4/5 at Monmouth in his second start, the 1992 GII Sapling, and also winning, in a well-spaced campaign, the seven-furlong GII Arlington-Washington Futurity, and the 1 1/16-mile GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. There wasn't much argument about who deserved the two-year-old championship that year. Unfortunately, sickness and injury kept him off the track most of his three-year-old year, but he came back to run a cracking third in the 1993 Breeders' Cup Sprint after a 12-month layoff.

Belong to Me was a fast horse, too, and a very well-bred one. Trained by the Master, Allen Jerkens, he progressed throughout his three-year-old year and finished up winning six races, including the GIII Best Turn and GIII Boojum (his career best effort, in his final start). He was a thorough six-furlong horse, and in fact has quite an interesting pedigree in that respect. It's obviously a good pedigree--he's by Danzig out of a daughter of Straight Deal by Exclusive Native. Danzig, we know, can get a good sprinter, and so can the family. The dam, Belonging, is in fact a three-quarter sister to two crack five-furlong sprinters, Premiership and Commemorate. Interestingly, these two full brothers are at nearly opposite ends of the spectrum as sires: Premiership started out in Florida and proved so successful he's now graduated to Kentucky, while Commemorate has stood in about four different states and is now standing in Iowa. Suffice to say, if Belong to Me leaves New York, he won't be going to Iowa.

Just in case you were thinking that it's been a couple of weeks since you heard a Coolmore success story, let me bring you up to date on Brief Truce, current leading freshman sire of winners in Europe with seven. He's second in earnings at the moment. Another sprinting son of Danzig, shock 1993 G1 July Cup winner Hamas (Ire), has claimed the top spot as two of his winners are stakes winners in Italy. But Brief Truce (an ironic name for a stallion standing in Ireland, huh?) is on the case. He doesn't have a stakes winner yet, but two of his winning fillies--six of his first seven winners are fillies--have placed in good stakes. Hopping Higgins (Ire), named after a snooker player, has been second in two stakes including Royal Ascot's G3 Norfolk, and Forest Treasure (Ire) was third in the G3 Cherry Hinton. European first-crop earnings figures were provided by Richard Craddock's Hyperion Promotions, through July 6.

Here's another who has every right to make a sire. Bred and raced by Moyglare Stud, Brief Truce is by Irish River (Fr) out of Falafel, by Northern Dancer from the family of Lammtarra and Bosra Sham, no less. He was a cracking good racehorse, too: he ran 10 times and was never out of the first three. He won his only start at two, and broke down when third in his only start at four, the GII Shoemaker H. At three he won the G1 St. James's Palace S. and placed in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas, G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp, G1 Queen Elizabeth S. and GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Gulfstream Park. He was bought by Coolmore at the end of his racing career, and he, too, has plenty of foals going for him--73, at last count. But take nothing away from him: this horse had the credentials, and he is delivering.

Two other European freshman sires with the Gone West connection are making the right signs as well, though each has just two winners to date. These are Gone West's best son, Zafonic, who already has a stakes winner in Bodyguard (GB); and Gone West's full brother, Lion Cavern, whose yearlings sold so well last year he finished up second-leading first-year sire on yearling average in Europe in 1996, to Zafonic. The two of them were second and third behind Kingmambo when North American and European results were combined.
